AN ORDER REVITALIZING THE BARANGAY ANTI- DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (BADAC) OF BARANGAY _____

WHEREAS, Section 9, Article I of the 1987 Constitution mandates the state shall, among other things, promote an improved quality of the life for all;

WHEREAS, Section 16 Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the local government units shall pursue undertaking to improve public moral and maintain peace and order among other concerns;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2015-63 Dated June 16, 2015 provides for the "Revitalization of the Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Council (BADAC) and their Role in Drug-Clearing Operations";

WHEREAS, Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) Regulation No. 3 s. 2017 provides for "Strengthening the Implementation of Barangay Drug-Clearing Program";

WHEREAS, DILG-DDB Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 dated May 21, 2018 provides for the "Implementing Guidelines on the Functionality and Effectiveness of Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (LADAC)" emphasizing on the critical role of LADACs in the coordination and proper monitoring of drug-related incidents, necessitating structural consistency and comprehensive monitoring and reporting system;

NOW, THEREFORE, I _____, Punong Barangay of Barangay _____, by virtue of the power vested in me by Law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. RECONSTITUTION AND COMPOSITION. The Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Council (BADAC) is hereby reconstituted and shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The roles and responsibilities of the BADAC are as follows:

1. Formulate a **BADAC Plan of Action** to be submitted to the CADAC/MADAC, copy furnished the DILG City/Municipal Field Offices
 - o Set quarterly targets to reduce the level of drug affectation and ultimately achieve drug-free status and maintain the status of drug-cleared and unaffected barangays;
 - o Empower the community in reporting drug-related cases through an Award/Commendation System;
2. Organize **BADAC Auxiliary Team** and orient them of their roles and functions in formulating a plan of action to address the drug problem;
3. **Equip Barangay Tanods and BADAC Auxiliary Team** on their roles and functions in the campaign against street level illegal drug trade through seminars and trainings;
4. **Identify drug-affected places** (i.e. workplace, house clusters, and streets) within respective barangays and immediately report to the PNP or PDEA;
5. **Determine and maintain record** of the names and **other pertinent information of residents**; and, likewise, **record, update and monitor all drug-related incidents/cases** reported or filed and its effect on the peace and order situation in the barangay including listings of suspected drug users and peddlers;
6. The BADAC, through its chairperson, shall consolidate **all information gathered** from all sources, related to any illegal drug activities within the barangay, to include names of users/peddlers, marijuana cultivation, clandestine drug laboratories, and **submit immediately to C/MADAC and local PNP for validation and formulation of watchlist**;
7. Ensure existence and operation of barangay rehabilitation and referral system, through the Barangay Rehabilitation and Referral Desk (**BADAC Desk**), intended for drug users and dependents who voluntarily surrendered;
8. Assist **PWUD who surrendered** to Barangay Rehabilitation and Referral Desk and **refer to C/M ADAC** and other institutions for appropriate action;

- SECTION 3. BADAC COMMITTEES AND ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.** The BADAC Committee on Operations, and Committee on Advocacy, are likewise reconstituted and shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 4. BADAC AUXILIARY TEAM (BAT). The Barangay Auxillary Team shall be made up of members who are residents of the barangay **with good repute for probity and integrity**. There should at least be 25 members in every 2,000 population (or 1:80).

The **roles and responsibilities** of the BAT are as follows:

1. Identify and report to BADAC, drug dependents, suspected drug personalities, illegal drug laboratories within their respective areas;
2. Assist in the conduct of Information and Education Campaigns (IECs);
3. Help facilitate in the preparation and distribution of information materials in collaboration with the school, neighborhood association, etc.;
4. Report existing community-based rehabilitation programs;
5. Conduct neighborhood activities to prevent drug addiction Sec. 5, DDB Board Regulation No. 3, s. 2017

SECTION 5. ORGANIZATION OF BARANGAY HOUSE CLUSTERS. The organization of Barangay House Cluster shall be based on the number of streets or puroks in the Barangay. The following are hereby designated as cluster leaders:

SECTION 6. FUNCTIONS OF BARANGAY CLUSTER LEADERS. Designated cluster leaders shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Attend BADAC regular meetings, upon instruction of the Punong Barangay;
2. Prepare and maintain list of individuals or residents in every household within the assigned cluster;
3. Immediately inform or report to the BADAC any illegal drug-related activities or cases occurring within the assigned cluster; and
4. Perform other duties as may be assigned by the Punong Barangay.

SECTION 7. REPORTS. The BADAC, through the Secretariat, shall submit the following reports on the implementation of the BADAC Plan of Action (drug-clearing operations) using the following schedule:

- Accomplishment Report – Accomplishment report vis-a-vis BADAC Action Plan to be submitted monthly to the CADAC;
- Monitoring Report of PWUD who surrendered – progress report on PWUDs who surrendered to be submitted quarterly to the CADAC;
- BADAC Monitoring Report – BADAC Action Plan, Composition, and amount of budget allocated to be submitted annually to the CLGOO;
- Consolidated Information Report – report on suspected drug personalities to be submitted regularly to the CADAC and Local PNP;

SECTION 8. FUNDING. As prescribed under DILG memorandum Circular No. 2021-044 dated April 14, 2021, a substantial portion of the Annual Budget shall be allocated to assist or enhance the enforcement of the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act, giving priority to educational programs on drug abuse prevention and control, and rehabilitation and treatment of drug dependents, the amount of which shall be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay based on the perceived need of the barangay.

SECTION 9. REPEAL. All other orders, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
