Rising 5th-8th Grade Required Summer Reading Lists and Assignment

Students must choose a book from their rising grade level (or one grade level above) to read, complete the appropriate book report form*, and submit it to their Language Arts Teacher on the first day of school. *Please be sure to select a novel that the student has not read previously.*

It is *mandatory* that your child read at least one book from the pertinent list. The book selected should be one that the student can read independently or with little assistance from parents. Most of these books are available in print and/or electronic versions are available through the public library system. If a student cannot find a book that he/she would like to read, and does not want to purchase it, he/she should ask the Language Arts Teacher, if there are any copies available for loan.

Although these books are recommended highly by various sources, we recommend that parents participate in your child's summer reading because there may be some issues within a given book that you may deem unsuitable for your child. One source for summaries and reviews is www.amazon.com.
