Common Questions

How will we be connecting in the future?

We will plan to use the same streaming approach for Sunday Mornings until Public Health restrictions are lifted.

How will Sunday evening and Wednesday night bible study be handled?

Due to the mandate that all citizens practice social distancing, we are CANCELLING the Sunday evening service and the Wednesday night Bible Class. The building will be CLOSED.

For those who work on Sunday mornings and use Sunday evening to worship God and partake of the Lord's Supper, the video for the Sunday morning service will be saved on our <u>YouTube page</u>, and we invite you to watch the video and participate in the Lord's Supper with unleavened bread and grape juice in your home.

And in the absence of the Wednesday Bible Study, to get your mid-week spiritual boost, we encourage you to check out the other videos that we have on our YouTube page. We plan to revisit this issue week-to-week as the COVID-19 pandemic issue continues to evolve.

In response to the COVID-19 virus, public health measures have been implemented by Toronto Public Health and the Ontario Government asking us to <u>avoid all public gatherings</u>, including Faith groups, greater than 50 people, and to practice social distancing whenever possible.

In the interest of our members and visitors, the Elders have made the decision to close the building at Strathmore Blvd for Sunday AM Services and implement alternative ways for us to continue to share in God's Word.

Recognizing that we want to make things accessible for everyone in the congregation, members are encouraged to use these alternative (i.e. online) methods as much as possible.

Currently, the detailed plans are that:

- The church building will be closed for Sunday AM Service
 - o 10:00 a.m. Bible study

10:45 a.m. - Intermission

11:00 a.m. - Worship Service

- More details will follow on how we plan to stream the morning service and adult bible class
- We are encouraged to stay at home, or to meet in very small groups
- All group activities are suspended until at least the end of April: Potluck, ladies class, mens breakfast, baby shower.
- Typically, Sunday Evening services and Wednesday night bible study are attended by well under 50 members, so these are planned to stay in place
- For contributions you may:
 - Save and put it aside your contribution until things are back to normal
 - If you write cheques, you may send donations in the mail (do not send cash in the mail)
 - You may drop your donation in the Strathmore mail slot (again, not cash)
