In School/Summer Internship

1. **Definition:** Help students to identify their career interests, assess their employability skills and training needs, and develop the skills and attitudes necessary to enter the workforce.

What it is: General Work Experience or Work Experience tied to the student's interest. Placement is tied to a community partnership, and school personnel must supervise the WBL experience.

What it's not: A student getting a job on their own and the school turns around and calls it a school or summer internship.

2. **In School/Summer Internship (examples):**
 - a. RCSD Student Internship Program
 - b. Summer of Opportunity Program

Instructions - Must be supervised by an instructional staff member, administrator, or school counselor.
