



ONEPRIDE PERIOD

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is OnePride Period? Why are we doing this?	It is a 50-minute period when all students and staff are available to get extra help and/or makeup work. We will also use this period for special assemblies and class meetings as needed. Because this period is in the middle of the day, ALL students will be required to take advantage of this time, regardless of their work schedules, transportation needs, or involvement in TCD, sports, and activities outside of the school day. This time can be used as an opportunity for intervention or acceleration. For example, AP courses may use this time for extra support and review.
2. When is the OnePride Period?	The OnePride Period will be held on the second, third, and fourth Wednesdays of the month from 10:50-11:40 am.
3. Is attendance taken during the OnePride Period?	Yes. All students will have a teacher/activity to report to. Teachers will take attendance. Absences will be dealt with in the same way as absences from class are addressed.
4. When does this schedule start?	OnePride begins on August 26th. See the school calendar for the dates of the OnePride Periods for the rest of the school year.
5. How does the OnePride Period affect the daily bell schedule?	We have a bell schedule for OnePride Period days. Classes will be 41 minutes long. Lunch periods will be 27 minutes long. Students will still be dismissed at 2:37 pm.
6. What are the options I can choose from during the OnePride period?	At the start of the school year, students may choose to go to any teacher's classroom, complete assessments in the Testing Center in Rm. 112, or complete PE Make-ups in the Weight Room OR remain in assigned OnePride Den. These options MAY expand as the school year progresses.
7. How do I know where to go during OnePride Periods? How will I choose the activity that I want?	Students will use SmartPass to see their OnePride Period activity. Look in the Calendar on the appropriate day. • If you have been assigned to a teacher's classroom, you will see a pass to that teacher at 10:50 am. You will not be able to change this. • If you were not assigned, you may choose where you wish to go during OnePride Period. You will see a tile on the calendar at 10:50 am that says "OnePride Period - Schedule". Students can click on



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	this to choose an option. *Students will be provided instruction on this process.- See Slideshow
8. What if the teacher/activity I want to go to during OnePride is “full” when I try to choose it?	Students will choose teachers/activities for OnePride starting Monday morning. This is a “first-come come-first first-served” basis. Once a teacher or activity reaches its maximum capacity, a student will need to make a different choice or remain in OnePride Den.
9. What happens if I don’t choose an option?	Any student who has not chosen an option by Tuesday at 3:00 pm will remain in their assigned DEN in PowerSchool.
