Board Work Session Meeting Minutes, Tuesday, March 3, 2026, 6:00 p.m.

The Board of Education of the Mooresville Graded School District met in a Board Business Meeting on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at the Mooresville Town Hall, 413 N. Main St., Mooresville, NC 28115.

Mr. Whitfield, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:00pm and called for a moment of silence before recognizing National Reading Month. Mr. Whitfield thanked the educators and families, and all who encourage literacy; and in honor of Dr. Seuss's birthday, stated, "the more that you read, the more you will know." Dr. Gardner then invited Charbel Awad, February 2026 Student of the Month, and Kiyan Witherspoon, March 2026 Student of the Month, to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Agenda: On a motion by Kerry Pennell, seconded by Rakeem Brawley, the board voted 5-0 to approve the meeting agenda as presented.

Approval of the Minutes: On a motion by Debbie Marsh, seconded by Monica Bender, the board voted 5-0 to approve the minutes from the January 6, 2026, January 27, 2026 and February 17, 2026 meetings as presented.

ABCD Award: The School Board recognized and presented the February 2026 Above and Beyond the Call of Duty Award to Ms. Ella Donahue, Instructional Assistant at Rocky River Elementary School. Ms. Donahue was nominated by Kaylor Kaemba, Principal and Lani Earnhart, Assistant Principal for demonstrating the MGSD Core Values. The School Board also recognized and presented the March 2026 Above and Beyond the Call of Duty Award to Ms. Keyona Foye, TSC Teacher Assistant at Park View Elementary School. Ms. Foye was nominated by Dr. Misha Rogers, Principal and Jennifer Marshall, Assistant Principal for demonstrating the MGSD Core Values.

School Highlights: Rocky River Elementary School Principal, Kayor Kaemba, and Assistant Principal, Lani Earnhardt presented highlights around oral reading fluency, writing and comprehension. They shared that students are thriving with this rigorous literacy focus, instructional staff support the growth and instruction of building a strong literacy foundation, and that data and student samples show growth in fluency and comprehension just from BOY to MOY.

Park View Elementary School Principal, Dr. Misha Rogers, accompanied by PVES Teachers Brittany Starnes and Jessy DeFrancisco, showcased how the school is taking a data-driven approach to results, turning i-Ready data into math growth that matters.

Public Comment: There was 1 individual signed up for public comment. The public comment period began at 6:54 p.m. Ms. Anyah Jones of Mooresville spoke on the topic of student conduct. **Public comments concluded at 6:57 p.m.**

Items for Information:

- A. Skills for the Future Update:** Chief of Schools, Jonathan Ribbick, along with Dr. Tracey Waid, Director of Secondary Instruction, and Rob Orrill, Director of Accountability presented an update on the Skills for the Future pilot. Mooresville Graded School District is one of 3 pilot districts in North Carolina to be part of the "Skills for the Future" project. This project is a collaborative effort aimed at strengthening integration of durable skills into classroom practice and assessment, with the goal of preparing students for a wide range of post-secondary options. Ms. Pennell inquired about the type of response we've had from the community. Dr. Waid shared that the Iredell EDC has been a great partner, and that we are always looking for additional support from the community in terms of guest speakers, mentors, and job shadow opportunities as well. Dr. Marsh asked if we are looking at ways of incorporating this with younger students. Dr. Waid shared that the district is focusing on these durable skills at the elementary level as well, specifically with work being done on the Gateway projects. Mr. Brawley shared that another opportunity for community involvement would be to invite our alumni to come back and share their stories.
- B. 2026 Summer Programming:** Mr. Ribbeck and Dr. Waid were then joined by Director of Elementary Instruction, Jemma Conley, to share the summer programming opportunities to address students needing additional academic support. This includes: YReaders, Read to Achieve, Summer School at MHS for Credit Recovery, and Summer School at NFW for New & Credit Recovery. In addition to academic programming, the district will offer transitional support for students moving to new secondary schools through WEB Leaders at MMS & SBMS and LINK Leaders at MHS.

Items for Approval:

- A. 2026-27 MGSD Budget:** On January 27 2026, at the Board of Education work session, MGSD presented the proposed budget for the 2026-2027 school year. To comply with the FY26 budget

calendar set by Iredell County, we are submitting our proposed budget for the 2026-2027 school year, so we are seeking approval at this time. **On a motion by Rakeem Brawley, seconded by Debbie Marsh, the board voted 5-0 to approve the 2026-27 MGSD Budget.**

B. BASP & STARS Rate Increase: The Before and After School Program (BASP) is requesting an additional pricing component to cover full day care on teacher workdays. The proposed fee for full day care on these days is \$20 and will help ensure that care is utilized by parents after staffing commitments are made. The STARS program is requesting a rate increase to keep up with the rise in operating costs. The current monthly rate is \$575 per month and the proposed rate is \$650 per month. Both new rate structures, if approved, would go into effect beginning with the 2026/2027 school year. **On a motion by Monica Bender, seconded by Kerry Pennell, the board voted 5-0 to approve the BASP & STARS Rate Increases.**

C. MGSD Policies: MGSD works with the North Carolina School Board Association (NCSBA) to ensure we complete timely revisions of our BOE policies. All of the updates have been recommended by the NCSBA with revisions made specific to Mooresville Graded School District policies and procedures. The policy update recommendations were shared at the January 6, 2026 BOE meeting for review:

This Committee's primary tasks are to develop the survey that is distributed to every school board member statewide and to then create the Draft 2027-28 NCSBA Legislative Agenda for consideration and adoption by the Delegate Assembly at November's Annual Conference. Ms. Bender expressed interest in participating. **On a motion by Debbie Marsh, seconded by Kerry Pennell, the board voted 5-0 to nominate Monica Bender for the NCSBA Legislative Committee.**

- E. Budget Amendments:** Ms. Angie Davis, Chief Financial Officer, shared plans to reallocate funds since the 2025-2026 budget was adopted. **On a motion by Monica Bender, seconded by Rakeem Brawley, the board voted 5-0 to approve the Budget Amendments as presented.**

Closed Session: According to **NC G.S. §143-318.11 subsections (a)(1), (a)(3) & (a)(6)**, Mr. Whitfield, Board Chair, requested the board go into a closed session to prevent the disclosure of information that is not considered public record, review personnel and consult with the board attorney. **On a motion by Debbie Marsh, seconded by Rakeem Brawley, the board voted 5-0 to go into closed session.**
