

City Tools - The Northgate Opportunity in Housing Services

Context

On 13 November, the London Office of Technology and Innovation (LOTI) and Bloomberg Associates, released *City Tools: London*, a report and interactive dashboard that maps technologies, contracts and skills across London's boroughs. By making this information transparent and easily accessible, the intention is that boroughs will be able to identify new opportunities to collaborate, re-shape the government technology market and improve service delivery for Londoners.

The report highlighted an immediate collaboration opportunity for boroughs. Northgate contracts for housing services in seven boroughs are due for renewal from March 2020. In this workshop, we wish to engage with CIOs and Housing Directors in the seven concerned boroughs to 1) explore the opportunities to improve procurement in this specific area through collaboration; 2) outline the problems and concerns boroughs have experienced with their Northgate housing contracts, and 3) agree on specific solutions we can implement in the short and long term.
