



Day 1

Arrive at **Port Blair**. Check-in in hotel. Visit **Corbyn's Cove Beach** in the evening. This beach has a small curve of sand backed by palms. The coastal road here is a scenic journey, and passes several Japanese World War II bunkers along the way. Night stay at Port Blair.

Day 2

Port Blair Local Sightseeing



Today we will discover the local beauty of Port Blair. **Chatham Saw Mill** is Asia's biggest and oldest saw mill and is a popular tourist destination. The mill dates back to 1883 and was set up by the British. Our second destination will be **Ross Island**. This island was the Administrative Headquarters for the Andaman's, before an earthquake rocked it in 1941. The headquarters were then shifted to Port Blair. One can see remnants of an opulent past in the ruins of the church, swimming pool and the chief commissioner's residence with its huge gardens and grand ballrooms.

Samudrika – Naval Marine Museum is run by the Indian Navy, this museum has a diverse range of exhibits with informative coverage of the islands' ecosystem, tribal communities, plants, animals and marine life (including a small aquarium). The visit to museum will give the fare idea what we will be experiencing while our water sport activities like Snorkeling, Scuba and Glass Bottom ride in coral islands next day.



Our day tour will end after visiting historically important place **Cellular jail** (Kala Pani) and Light and sound show. The prison was used by the British especially to exile political prisoners to the remote archipelago. Many notable dissidents such as Veer Savarkar and Batukeshwar Dutt,

among others, were imprisoned here during the struggle for India's independence. The story narrated during the sound and light show infuses and inspires patriotism. The show is the must visit for every Indian citizen. Night stay at Port Blair.



Day 3

Day tour to Jolly Buoy Island.



Jolly Buoy is an another "Must Visit" destination in Andaman. One can enjoy the underwater coral view through snorkeling and from the glass bottom boat. This Island is a part of Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park which is a unique project in the world. The marine park is spread out in open sea, creeks and 15 islands over an area of approx. 280sq kms. Jolly Buoy is one of these 15 islands and rich in marine and coral life.



Some of fishes seen here are clown fish, butterfly fish, surgeon fish, angel fish, parrot fish, bat fish and groupers. White tip shark, hammer-headed shark, manta ray and blue fin jack are also occasionally seen. More than 50 types of corals are found in the fringing coral reefs in the park. Some important coral varieties found here are Acropora, Pocillopora, Montipora, Leptosereis, Fungia, Portia, Tubipora and Gorgonians. In the evening visit **Anthropological Museum**. This museum provides a thorough and sympathetic portrait of the islands' indigenous tribal communities. Night stay at Port Blair.



Day 4

Tour to Havelock Island

Take a Macruzz (Island Cruize) for **Havelock Island**. The island is named after a British General, "Henry Havelock" who served in India. After lunch Visit **Vijaynagar Beach** (Beach No. 5) In the evening visit **Radhanagar Beach** (Beach No. 7) is one of the most popular beaches on Havelock and was named "Best Beach in Asia" by Time Magazine in 2004, Night stay at Havelock.



Day 5

Enjoy the marine life thru scuba diving. After lunch travel back to Port Blair. Night stay at Port Blair.



Day 6

Early morning departure to **Barathang Island** thru The Great Andaman Trunk Road. Take a rare chance to spot Jarawas (tribes at middle Andaman) Visit **Limestone caves** and **Dhani Nullah Mangrove walk**. Watch turtle nesting at **Kalipur Beach**. Night stay at Diglipur.



Day 7

Early morning visit beach to see **Turtle Hatchlings**. Visit **Ross & Smith twin Islands**. Ross & Smith Islands are twin islands bridged by pristine white sandy beach that has a swimming pool lagoon on one side and a snorkeling paradise on the other. Visit **Mud Volcano** after lunch. Watch turtle nesting at Kalipur Beach in the evening. Night stay at Diglipur.



Day 8

Travel back to Port Blair. Evening free for shopping. Night stay at Port Blair.

Day 9

Return flight to Mumbai.
