

 Video Script: "Career and Right Livelihood"

 Scene 1: [Soft sunrise over a city skyline. People preparing for work: dressing, commuting.]

 Narrator (gentle voice):

"Every morning, the world awakens...

Millions step into their jobs.

"Right livelihood is not about what you do,

but how you do it —

with mindfulness, compassion... and purpose."

 Text on screen:

"Work is not separate from the path.

Work is the path."
