GATE PROBLEMS

We continue to work with our gate contractor to resolve ongoing issues with our gate remotes. Many changes are going on with cell towers and infrastructure that affect certain areas, and we happen to be in one of those areas.

When **using your remote**, pull close to the gate then hold the button down and move it around, pointing it at the gate. It should eventually connect. A better solution is to **use your cell phone** to call the gate directly to open it.
