## Section 1: Introduction

Welcome to Omicron's Spear, or OS-6. We are the division in charge of medical research and its applications, along with Amnestics production. We will be working jointly with the Medical Department along with other divisions to accomplish our tasks. We will be the Division that gets priority on amnestic production, autopsies and biopsies, along with any other medical and chemical research activity that needs our attention. If you have any questions about how to proceed and do well in this division, feel free to DM Executive Researcher Oren through discord or ask for me in game if you notice I am on the server.

## Section 2: Expectations and Duties

We expect all members of OS-6 to come in with a decent knowledge of medical terminology and anatomy. If you do not have this knowledge, do not panic. We can help bring you up to the level we want after you join or before. Also, we expect our members to be professional at all times and be able to write comprehensive documents on their work. Our duties will be to do joint research with the Medical Department, specifically performing examinations from a medical perspective on all the SCP's we can at Site-56. We also are in charge of amnestic production. This means we will handle pricing and supply for our MTF Units, DoI, and Site Admin/Command. If you have any questions regarding your duties and any expectations you feel unsure of, feel free to ask an OS-6 lead.

## Section 3: Rules

1. Be professional at all times. Any report of a member of OS-6 misbehaving will not be taken lightly. Our division is important and we want to be respected.
2. Keep up a steady workflow. This means having a goal of completing a Research Study at least every two weeks, aiming for completion in one. Breaks are also important! Burnout exists, and it sucks. Take breaks when you need them, just remember to contact a Division lead if it is longer than 5 days.
3. Do not misuse amnestics! This means that you will not use any amnestics you make while on a Research job unless authorized to.
4. Before selling amnestics, check the SOP for the current price of the type of amnestic you are selling. It will be updated throughout the week to match supply and demand.
5. Do not, under any circumstances, break server rules. If you get too many warnings or get banned, your position in OS-6 will be in jeopardy.

## Section 4: Guidelines and Procedures

- Make sure to align our divisions' orders within the goals and rules of the Foundation. We are not trying to tear the organization we work for apart.
- Amnestics may be produced by any member of OS-6, but members of our amnestic teams get priority on manufacturing and selling.
- Medical tests still need to be ethical. If a biopsy or autopsy is performed on a sentient SCP, ask it if it will cooperate with you to allow you to perform one. If not, go to a Division lead and they will help you sort out how to perform one ethically.
- You may recommend people to join OS-6 and direct them to a Division lead. They shall determine if the person you recommended is currently fit to join and help them if they are not.
- You may not sell amnestics to anyone outside of these groups: MTF, Site Admin, Site Command, Intel, and IA. IA is with approval as there are situations where they may need it.

## Section 5: Chain of Command

Chain of Command in OS-6 is somewhat weird, so this will go into depth on who is where and who you go to first.

- Division Leads
- Subdivision Heads
- Doctors/Amnestics Producers
- Researchers
- New Hires

New hires shall stay a new hire until they have proved themselves.

Researchers are just members of OS-6 who have proved themselves.

Doctors and Amnestics Producers are fully trusted members of OS-6 who help Subdivision heads and higher in managing and keeping tabs on members of OS-6.

Subdivision heads are second in command to Division leads, and will be in charge of the subdivisions in our absence. Subdivisions will be split between Chemical and Medical Research here. Both are equal and are in charge of different things.

## Section 6: Medical Procedures

The medical subdivision handles medical evaluations and procedures on SCP's. This includes, but is not limited to, physicals, psych evals, blood testing of SCP's, and biopsies. When preparing to do any of these, check with a Subdivision head or higher with a prepared document. We need to make sure our tests are ethical and within guidelines. We want to keep these SCP's alive and comfortable while being contained at our Site, even if they try to kill us a lot. We currently have a Medical Evaluation of SCP-049 with a psych eval attached. That document should be used as an example of how to conduct and structure those tests.

## Section 7: Amnestic Procedures, Guidelines, and Clearances

Amnestics production is a very important part of our job in OS-6. We will produce Class A and B amnestics normally, with others being made when needed. You are only allowed to make Class A and B without needing permission, anything other than that you will need to ask and see if anyone needs it. Also, any amnestics above Class C is level 4 Clearance and higher. Class C itself is level 3. Do not spread information about amnestics to those who are not aware of it. When selling amnestics, check this document for current and up to date prices. If you notice price discrepancies, please let Subdivision heads or higher know. Next, amnestic production itself. The Medical Department gets priority on Amnestics production, so you will need to talk to the Subdivision head of amnestics before producing them if you are on Research when wanting to produce amnestics. This does not mean switching over to medical to avoid asking for permission, this means that medical gets a stronger standing in the Site as they aren't as present as a lot of us would love for them to be due to them getting sidelined a bit.
