Older Children are invited to decorate cookies and cards while the first movie is playing- unless they want to enjoy a double feature, which they are welcome to do.

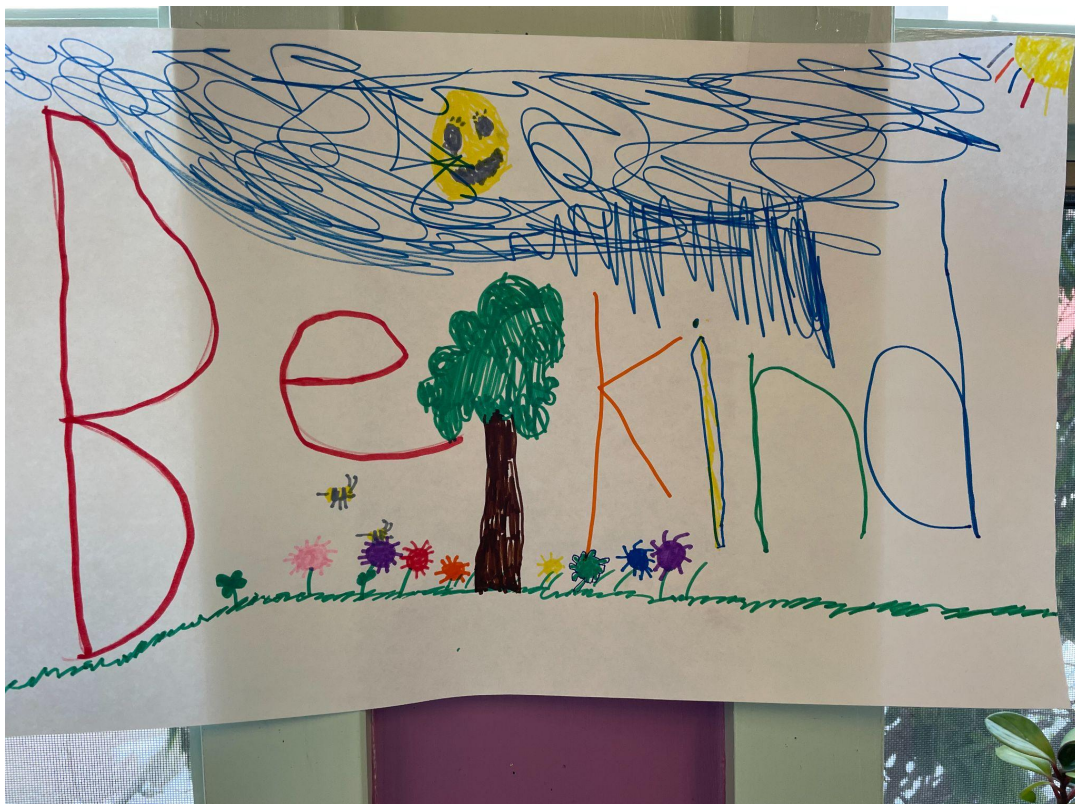
