- We are currently hiring for regular counselors and inclusion counselors.
 - Little note for pay: We updated the official listing online to have the proper hiring process listed but then we just got raises city wide. This means the links to the posting will have everything .75 an hour below the actual rate.

- General counselors will handle at most 10 kids day to day and will commonly have a co-counselor.
- We spend three days a week outside at Vago Park with our kids and two at Aquaport, the pool by the Maryland Heights community center.
- Counselors will be CPR and first aid trained through the city but are required to get drug tested after passing through the first interview.
- They will work between 30-40 in a week and must be available June-August or give notice at their interview that they will be on a trip a given week.
- The pay for this role is currently set at \$14.50 an hour.

- This role will work individually with children that are on an IEP plan through their school district.
- We have a city inclusion coordinator that will take that IEP and put together a plan alongside the student's counselor in order to create resources and tools that will aid that student in participating in activities alongside fellow campers.
- The student and counselor will follow the same routine and schedule as the standard counselors going to the pool twice a week with their child.
- These counselors are also required to complete CPR, first aid and drug testing but no other certifications are required.
- The pay for this role is currently set at \$16 an hour.
