We may be busy or burdened by our routine tasks and responsibilities, but it’s always healthy to slow down and re-center on our foundation in Christ. This next series will give our students the chance to do exactly that.

Series Overview

3 Tough Questions is a three-session series that delves into some of the most profound inquiries about faith:

Session 1: What Do I Do When Bad Things Happen?

Big Idea: Even when it may feel like it, God is not neutral in the face of evil.

Scripture: The book of Micah

Question for Discussion: How can we find hope and strength in our faith during difficult times?

Session 2: Can I Trust The Bible?

Big Idea: The Bible is trustworthy and life-changing.

Scripture: 2 Timothy 5:10-17

Question for Discussion: What are some reasons we can trust the Bible as a reliable source of truth and guidance?

Session 3: Did The Resurrection Really Happen?

Big Idea: The Resurrection definitely happened, and it changes everything.

Scripture: Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24, John 20

Question for Discussion: What does the Resurrection mean for us as believers? Why do you think it’s important that we know it *actually* happened?

This series offers a safe space for our students to explore their doubts, wrestle with the real things they’re experiencing in the world around them, and seek answers at their own pace. We encourage you, as parents, to hold the same degree of space at home to help them make connections between an intellectual faith and daily life.
