HOW DO I ACCESS MVLA'S STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (SIS) PORTAL?

Go to www.mvla.net. Under STUDENT & PARENTS, click on **Aeries Student Info System** to be taken to the log-in page.

You may also access the SIS Portal by clicking on the link provided in the email you received from the district.

SIS Student Log On:

1. Enter the MVLA email address (9-digit permanentID#@mvla.net) and click NEXT
2. Enter password (password was emailed to your MVLA Google email account) and click NEXT
3. You are now logged into your SIS account

SIS Parent Log On:

we have a parent email in our system, you should have received an email from the district, containing a link, username and password. You will need this to log into your SIS account.

If the email was deleted/misplaced, please enter the parent email address that was used for school registration into the **SIS Parent/Student Portal** log-on screen and click on "Forgot Password". You will be guided to reset your password and to log into the SIS portal.

HOW DO I CHOOSE MY COURSES?

All students will select courses in the **SIS Parent/Student Portal** using a parent or student SIS account. (see Course selection screenshot page)

1. Log into the **SIS Parent/Student Portal**.
2. Hover over "Classes" and click on "Course Requests Entry".
3. From the drop-down menu, select a subject or select "Show All Courses" and click Search.
4. To select a course, double click on the course name and it will pop up as the requested course on the left.
Note: You may click on the blue and white icon to view basic information about a course.
5. [Alternate Course Requests](#) can be listed so if you do not get first choices, click the link for directions.

Be advised that *course selection choices do not guarantee enrollment in your chosen courses!!*

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- The course selection window is open from **January 21- February 21, 2025**. You may revisit your SIS portal to make changes.
- If you do not select courses by **February 21st**, MVHS counselors will select courses for you.
- Review the list of courses available via the Course Selection Worksheet. [Course Selection Link Here](#).
- Detailed course, graduation and a-g requirements* information can be found by going to the campus website and clicking on "2024-2025 Course Catalog/Curriculum Handbook" under QUICK LINKS on the right side.
- Discuss course selections with parents and teachers.
- All sports/athletics and marching band/color guard meet after school.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SELECT MY COURSES?

- All freshmen will receive a letter confirming their preliminary course selections in **April 2025**
- Final schedules will be available at Freshmen Orientation upon confirmation of online data verification.
- Special education students' schedules will be adjusted to meet their IEP goals after the Spring transition meetings are held.

*a-g are the entrance requirements for California State University (CSU) and the University of California (UC)
