## Class Information

Dear Parents.

Welcome to our Kindergarten class family! Our names are Mrs. Travaglia and Mrs. Maccarello and we are your child's Kindergarten teachers this school year. ### • Emergency Cards

As soon as school starts, please send in your child's completed emergency card to school. We must have this on file in case of an emergency.

### Red Bus Tag

Please be sure your child has a completed red bus tag fastened to their backpack each day. Include your child's first and last name, address, phone number and the teacher's name on the bus tag. We are in room 107.

#### Arrival and Dismissal

Our day begins at approximately 8:30 each day. Please be sure your child comes to school on time every day. A a

If there is a change in your child's usual pick up procedure you <u>must let us know</u> at the beginning of the day.

#### Dress for School

We strongly suggest that children dress comfortably for school each day. Please allow children to wear comfortable shoes (sneakers are best) as the children participate in indoor and outdoor active play. We will do many learning projects and artistic activities this year. Please keep this in mind when dressing your child for school.

• PLEASE BRING IN A ZIPLOC BAGGIE OF CLEAN CLOTHES FOR YOU CHILD IN CASE THERE IS A NEED FOR YOUR CHILD TO CHANGE CLOTHES. We will keep the baggie in the classroom all year.

### Specials

We will go to one of the following specials each day: Art, Music, Library, Physical Education (Phys Ed. is two times each week). Children must wear sneakers for Physical Education class. Children will have the opportunity to take out a book from the Library each week (to be returned the following week). We will have a schedule available once school begins so that you are aware of your child's special of the day.

#### Homework

Some homework will be handed out in a packet form in Kindergarten. There will be no homework given in the first few weeks of school. There will also be announcements on the cover page of the HW packet. More specific information about homework will be given during Curriculum Night in September.

### • Birthdays

Your child will have the opportunity to celebrate his or her birthday in school. Your child's name will be announced over the loudspeaker for all to hear! We will provide a birthday crown and a small gift for your child.

We do not have birthday celebrations with food (cupcakes, juice, etc). You may choose to have your child hand out small, <u>PEANUT FREE</u> goodie bags for all of the children in the class. PLEASE LET US KNOW if you are planning to bring in small goodie bags for the class. If you are planning a party outside of school for your child, we will be more than happy to hand out invitations for your child.

### Toys and Devices

Personal toys (big and small), books and electronic devices should be left at home. We have many developmental toys and the children will have their own Chromebook that will be used daily here in school. Thank you for understanding.

#### • Class Contact List

You will have the opportunity to join our class contact list so others in the class will have access to your phone number and email address. We will provide you with a form to fill out so you may join the list.

#### • Parent Communication

We are always available to answer any questions you may have regarding your child's progress. We use **Parent Square** as the main form of communication. **Please select "Group Message" and send it to both of us. We will go over how to do this at Curriculum Night.** We will also hand out notes in your child's folder.

Curriculum Night will give you the opportunity to learn about the specifics of the Kindergarten Curriculum. We urge you to attend on the given date. In addition, we will schedule individual parent-teacher conferences in the Fall, Spring, or whenever needed.
