Upcoming Spring Break Reminders

Spring break will be **March 25th-March 31st** this school year. We ask that Summit students do not plan to leave early for holiday breaks. Please be mindful of the break that students are given and not extend vacations before or after that break. If students miss school, they are responsible for tracking and making up missed work via their teacher's Schoology pages. We also highly encourage students to attend office hours before and after their absence. Parents are responsible for making sure that any absences are reported to the office ahead of time. Please remember that each student is allotted 10 excused absences per year, and then a doctor's note will be required for any absence over those 10 days or it will go unexcused. As a charter school with a mission of academic excellence and strong demonstrations of learning, our participation in standardized testing is especially important. **Summit expects that all students participate and are in attendance for these assessments.** These tests provide a valid and reliable evaluation of each student's growth and progress towards state standards, and in turn, helps our teachers strengthen their instruction and provide data on our educational programming. Please encourage your students to show up as their best selves and put forth their best effort. All students will partake in CMAS testing from **Tuesday April 9 - Thursday April 11th**. 8th graders will take an additional CMAS Science test on **Monday, April 15 and Tuesday April 16th**. Testing will take place the first half of each day, and regular classes will run each afternoon. Please ensure your student eats a nutritious breakfast and comes to school prepared with a charged Chromebook, a book, and a water bottle.
