1. Mag Privileges – Bethany Howlett

- a. Bethany reviewed the current policies and procedures for privileges for Magnesium Sulfate. This applies only to Meriter.
- b. Bottom line
 - i. Mag privileges at Meriter are required if you are the attending ordering and managing mag sulfate for a patient with preE w/SF. OB consult is required by policy. DFMCH expects in-house resident support.
 - ii. If you do not have mag privileges, you can consult OB for them to manage mag while you continue to manage labor only. Standard in-house requirements apply (active labor, RN/resident request, etc.)
 - iii. FMOBs can request to update to their OB privileges at any time

b. Proposal 1: Transition FMONS to a 7-day service

- Attending week = Friday thru Thursday (aligns with FMS attending schedule)
- FMONS attending does PP/NB rounding only on weekends; OB Call person covers OB triage, labor, ante
- DFMCH Residency Faculty call group will vote on this proposal. We need 60% in favor to proceed with change.

c. Proposal 2: Options for changes to Community Faculty call models

- Option 1: Remain in Community OB Call Group with decreased call responsibilities**
 - Group will need to decide how to handle triage calls, and whether to change length of call.
- Option 2: Join Residency OB Call group with possibility to co-attend on FMONS**

d. Next Steps:

- ii. Once a draft schedule of the 7-day attending schedule is ready for residency faculty to review, they will vote on whether to switch to a 7-day FMONS attending schedule, and whether to start in July or January.
- iii. The April FMOB Faculty meeting will start with breakout groups for discussion.
- iv. Bethany will survey community faculty for their preference for Option 1 vs Option 2. Based on those results, Bethany will provide updated info on numbers and structure for Options 1 & 2.
- v. Each group will vote separately to approve Option 1 and Option 2.
