

Abinger Fair 2025 - Emergency & Ambulance Plan

Circulation to : Committee Members ; Stallholders ; St John's Ambulance Service

Any Medical Emergency should be reported immediately to the St John's Ambulance Service volunteers and to a committee member.

The St John's Ambulance Service tent is located by the children's playground and clearly identified with a red cross flag.

Any emergency should be reported to a committee member or to the compere who will make an announcement to alert the appropriate person.

Should you need to call 999

Please direct emergency vehicles to the entrance to the green at the junction with Sutton Lane, as follows :

POST CODE : RH5 6HZ

What3words : stay.tiles.forget

Approaching from Guildford direction on A25 – direct them up Raikes Lane and Sutton Lane to the corner of the green at the top of Sutton Lane.

Approaching from Dorking direction on A25

direct them into Hollow Lane and then up Donkey Lane to the corner of the green at the junction with Sutton Lane.

Please also note that there is a defibrillator on the wall of Evelyn Hall.

EVACUATION

If evacuation of the green is required, the PA will announce instructions.

Anyone on the green should make their way to one of the two car parks, Sutton Lane or Abinger Lane. A member of the safety group will be at the muster point.

Stallholders and Committee members to help direct the public.

Member of the Safety Group to ensure green is cleared if possible.

Overcrowding

In the event of overcrowding the ropes surrounding tossing the sheaf and the main arena will be lowered to allow people to spill over into the arena area, provided no events are in progress. The PA will announce any instructions.
