- Group 4

- Waimanalo - kids won't want to come to summer b/c they want fun things to do. Need fun activities. Try to do a drive through in the neighborhood to remind kids that they're still here.
- Will be challenge w/high unemployment. Unemployment benefits better than staff working summer at lower pay.
- Group 3
 - Waialua - Will have kids come in for summer programming.
 - We will offer extra math enrichment to make up for learning loss. Moving over funding saved from 4th quarter to summer to hire additional staff. Set up safety rules for kids.
 - Will provide free breakfast and lunch.
 - Principals had the opportunity to request for funding for their "summer hub." Our principal put in for 30 chromebooks to help with our programming. She said the DOE will not be asking for the funding supplies and equipment back once the program is over. The schools will be allowed to keep the resources. We intend to use it as a resource for middle school for the following school year. All coordinators should talk to their admin about options.
