Book Trailer Contest Guidelines

1. Book trailer must represent Maya and the Robot by Eve Ewing.
2. Entries must be original work completed by students.
3. Entries must be submitted by Friday, March 17th at 8p.m. to Flipgrid, link below.
4. Book title and author must be present in the trailer.
5. Book trailers may not be longer than 1 minute 30 seconds (1 minute length is preferred).
6. Book trailers should include the book's cover (please use an original photograph of the book's cover).
7. All used images and music must have proper citation. A source must be appropriately cited and clearly visible at the end of the book trailer. For an example please [click here](#). Feel free to make a copy of the template and edit it or create your own.
8. For images and music to use that are copyright free, consider exploring these websites:
 - a. [Britannica Image Quest](#) for images (Username: op17 Password: learn)
9. Videos are scored using a [Scoring Rubric](#)
10. Failure to follow these guidelines in full will result in disqualification.
11. All videos must be submitted to the [Book Trailer Flipgrid](#) by March 17th at 8 P.M.
