

## THE CHASTISEMENT OF OUR PEACE

### ISAIAH 53:4-8

#### I) THE PROMISE OF PEACE, 53:5.

- A) *SHALOM*, (HEB), 'soundness, completeness'. MB – The feeling that results from wholeness. "Entering into a state of wholeness...Shalom is the result of God's activity in covenant and is the result of righteousness...This sort of peace has its source in God." TWOT, vol.2, p 930,931. Ps.29:11; John 14:27; Eph.2:14.
- B) Isaiah's use of *SHALOM*, Is. 9:6,7; 26:3,12; 32:15-18; 48:18,22;52:7; 53:5; 54:10,13; 55:12; 57:2, 20,21; 59:8.
- C) New Testament Peace. *IRENE*, (GK), 'peace', from *EIRO*, 'to join'. MB – The feeling that results from being joined to Jesus! John 16:33; John 20:19-26; Acts 10:36; Rom.10:15,16; Rom.14:17; Rom.15:33; Rom.16:20; 1Cor.7:15; 2 Cor.13:11; Gal.5:22; Eph.2:14-16; 2 Pet.3:14; 1 Thes.5:23.

#### II) THE PRICE OF PEACE – His Chastisement, 53:5.

- A) Chastisement in Hebrew is *MUSAR*, used in 53:5 and means, 'to discipline, correct'. Deut. 11:2; Prov.3:11; Job 5:17; Jer. 30:14. Another word used is *YAWSAR* used in Ps. 6:1 and Ps. 38:1.
- B) What was this chastisement?
  - 1. "Stricken by God and Afflicted", 53:4-8.
    - a) *NAGA/NEGA*, (HEB), to make contact, strike, plague'. 53:4,8.
    - b) *NAGAPH* (another primary root), 'to strike or plague'. Exodus 8:2; 12:23,27; 1 Sam.25:38; 26:10; 2 Chron.21:14-18; Is. 19:22; 2 Chron.12:15; Zech.14:12.
    - c) *NAGAH* (another primary root), 'to strike'. Is.10:20,24; 11:4,15; 14:6; 27:7; 50:6; 57:17; Zech. 13:7.
    - d) *AFFLICTED, ANAH*, (HEB), 'to afflict or oppress'. Ps. 88:6-9,16; Lam.3:33.
  - 2. *WOUNDED/PIERCED, CHALAL*, (HEB), 'to wound fatally, bore through'. *CHALAL* is used in Jer. 51:52; Ps.69:26; 109:22. *MECHALEL* is used in Is.51:9; Zech. 12:10. "There was no stronger expression to be found in language to denote a violent, painful death." Keil & Delitzsh.
  - 3. *STRIPES*, 53:5.
  - 4. *BRUISED, DAKKA*, (HEB), 'crushed, dust, that which is crushed'. 53:5,10; Lam. 3:34; Ps.143:3.
  - 5. Put to grief, 53:4,10.
  - 6. Cut Off, 53:8.
  - 7. His soul became an offering for sin, 53:10,12; Rom.3:20-26; Jesus became our substitute, Heb. 9:28; 1 Pet.3:18; 2 Cor.5:21.

- C) “It pleased the Lord to Bruise him” (NKJ), “It was the will of the Lord to crush Him, He has put him to grief” (ESV).
- D) Covenant of Peace, 54:10. See also Mal. 2:5; Ezk. 34:25; 37:26; Matt. 26:26,28; Heb.13:20,21.

III) THE PRACTICE OF PEACE – HOW CAN WE EXPERIENCE PEACE?

- A) Believe/Trust, 53:1; John 12:38-41; Rom.5:1; John 1:7,12; Rom. 10:9-17; Is. 26:3; 27:5; Ps. 4:8; Col. 1:20.
- B) Obey, Isaiah 48:18; Ps. 119:165; Isaiah 9:6,7.
- C) Righteousness, Isaiah 32:17; Rom.14:17.
- D) Focus Mind on Jesus, Isaiah 26:3; 54:13; Rom.8:6; Col.3:1-3; Phil. 4:4-10.
- E) We need the healing ministry of Jesus, 53:5; Jer. 33:6.
