What is the Grizzly Learning Camp (GLC) and why should my student attend?

GLC is designed for ALL students! It's an engaging, in-person, morning program that helps students catch up or pushes them to stretch their skills with new challenges. We focus on hands-on, fun learning, and all students will participate in field trips to various locations throughout the area.

How is GLC different from traditional summer school?

Instead of the traditional summer school model, GLC partners with community-based organizations like the University of Michigan, Eastern Michigan University, and local businesses to provide real-world, hands-on experiences. Older students will visit colleges, participate in internships, complete service-learning projects, and enjoy mentoring opportunities. (Credit recovery for high school students is also included.)

Who is eligible to sign up, and how much does it cost?

All Ypsilanti Community Schools (YCS) students from Preschool through 12th grade are eligible to attend. GLC is completely **free of charge** for YCS families!

My Child does not currently attend YCS, can my child(ren) sign up?

Yes, if your child lives within the YCS district boundaries, transportation will be provided upon request (in the registration form).

Yes, if your child lives outside of the district boundaries, they are still welcome to participate; however, transportation must be provided by the parent or guardian.

Does my student have to attend every day?

We would love to have your student there every day! Consistent attendance provides the best learning opportunities, ensures they get the most out of the program, and guarantees they won't miss out on any of the fun.

Schedule & Locations

What are the dates for GLC?

The camp runs Monday through Thursday, beginning on **June 15** and ending on **July 23**.

Please note: There will be no camp on Thursday, June 18 in observance of Juneteenth, or Thursday, July 2 for the July 4th weekend.

Where will my student go to camp, and what are the hours?

Daily Logistics & Support

What grade level do I put down for summer?

Use this current school year (2025/2026). For example, if your scholar is currently in 2nd grade you would put 2nd grade. If your scholar is currently in 8th grade you would put 8th grade.

Is GLC half day?

Yes, GLC is a half day program. Please see the chart above for specific times.

Will transportation be provided?

Yes! Transportation is provided for YCS students in Preschool through 12th grade. **You must enroll by May 23** to ensure your student has transportation on the first day. If you enroll after May 23, it will take time to arrange, so please plan to transport your student yourself for the first few days.

When and how will I receive bus information?

Your student's teacher will contact you the week of June 8 with your specific pick-up and drop-off times and locations.

Will breakfast and lunch be provided?

Yes. YCS will provide breakfast, lunch, and occasional snacks for all campers.

What supplies or technology do I need to provide?

None! GLC will provide all necessary supplies and technology required for your student's program.

Registration & Next Steps

Why do I have to update my student's information if the school already has it?

Because students from across the district will be coming together at consolidated locations, some staff may not be familiar with your child's specific needs. Collecting updated information on the registration form ensures we can keep every student safe, healthy, and supported.

My student currently participates in EMU Bright Futures. How should I register them for the summer?

EMU Bright Futures is excited to partner with GLC again this year! Current in-person Bright Futures families should speak directly with their school site coordinator. They will help ensure your student is correctly enrolled in the summer sessions using the GLC enrollment form.

I filled out the enrollment form. What happens next?
