Thanks in part to a partnership grant from the Minnesota STEM Ecosystem, all registered attendees will be eligible to receive a stipend of \$200.

In addition to this partnership grant, we are thrilled to be able to offer partial travel bursaries for guests attending the MN+CS Conference. Bursaries will be selected and awarded by the Raspberry Pi Foundation. The aim of providing financial support is to help offset travel and accommodation costs associated with attending our events.

In order to be eligible to be considered, you must be a current educator and have to travel 60+ miles to attend the event.

Bursaries are intended to as a contribution to travel expenses such as fuel and reasonable hotel costs that are expected to be incurred as a result of attending this event.

The select criteria takes into account many factors including geography, role, and ensuring a diverse group of attendees.

The Raspberry Pi Foundation is not responsible for any individual attending the event. We reserve the right to terminate the agreed travel funds at any time, where the recipient holder no longer meets the terms and conditions stated here.

- Failure to attend the event will result in the bursary amount being payable back to the Raspberry Pi Foundation.
- Bursary applicants must complete the form sent by us, including their bank details. Payments are made on the first and third Wednesday of each month via BACS.
- If you have been approved to receive a bursary, you do not need to provide receipts.
- The Raspberry Pi Foundation is not responsible for any individual attending the event. It is your responsibility to make your own travel arrangements (including arranging any travel insurance if required). To the extent permitted by law, we accept no liability in connection with your travel to and from the event, or overnight costs.
