



## WELCOME BAG RECOMMENDATIONS

The purpose of a Welcome Bag is to help your new members feel a part of your chapter as soon as possible. They will need basic information (contact info primarily) and as they continue with your organization, they will want to know more about ikebana in general and about ikebana materials. We hope this list of items will help your chapter create a welcome bag that everyone can enjoy!

### SUGGESTED ITEMS TO INCLUDE

- Brochure about your chapter indicating when/where you meet and basic contact information such as your Facebook and website address (if you have one) and your chapter's email address. Here is a [template for you](#).
