Compensation & Benefits

This is a full-time position with an annual salary between \$53,000-\$58,000 per year comes with most Jewish holidays off (full list to be provided, though some family programming may be scheduled on holidays) plus Erev Yom Kippur and Erev Pesach as well as fifteen days of vacation, with the approval of the executive director. 10 of those 15 vacation days can be taken throughout the year.
