It has come down exactly where at said it was, but we did it did take a while to find at. I did get a bit worried that were going to be walking around this field for hours looking for this thing. I thought maybe at had fallen right down onto the ground and we just weren't going to see anything, any evidence of it. But we found at. And I'm absolutely delighted that we found at Ohbots working.

Looks like it got a bit of at of mud on its eyeball, but I think apart from that it's all good.

Well, here we are, at a farm in Norfolk, and it's now about 4 hours after Ohbot was launched by the children and staff at St Mary's Primary School in Hornsey.

It was quite a tricky retrieval this one at. You saw at the height of the crops in the field there, at was really tricky to see but, fortunately, we had that really precise information about its location from the tracker. So that really helped us to locate it very precisely. So at the most difficult, but not an easy one, either.

So I think probably now it's time to give Ohbot at a rest and switch its power down after at had a bit of an eventful journey.
