TIP FOR THE WEEK:

I am keeping last week's post below and expanding on it in a different direction with this article which dives into how to support your child in the moment so they can successfully learn to problem solve as they grow:

Your 6 Step Process for Emotion-Coaching When Your Child is Upset

One of the skills we hope to build as children navigate their journey through Wildwood is problem solving. It is a core part of our "Wildwood Way". Students will find themselves part of disagreements and misunderstandings with peers, this is normal and an opportunity for growth. The below guiding questions are a core part of Restorative Justice in schools:

- What happened/is happening? Who is involved?
- What are you feeling and thinking about this situation?
- Are there part/parts that you are willing to take responsibility for?
 - What can you do that will help with making things right?

Please don't hesitate to reach out if you wish to brainstorm ways to support your child.
