Retired Colors

Official Hall of Fame colors that were permanently retired from the standard lineup.



Discontinued Colors

Colors that ceased production without becoming official Hall of Fame retirements.



Color Name Changes

Historical color names that later continued under a different official Crayola name.



Specialty Wrapper Variations

Magic Scents, Color 'n Smell, limited editions, promotional colors, and other special wrapper releases.

Research Queue

Items currently being investigated or verified through original packaging, collector resources, and historical documentation.
