PE KIT

PE kit should also be purchased from [Stevensons](#), with the exception of the following items which can be purchased from any shop:

- navy shorts (Nursery to Year 2)
- black/blue swimsuit
- House T-shirt*
- white ankle socks
- navy drawstring PE bag
- gum shield †

PE Kit should be kept in school to change into before PE lessons. This will ensure that appropriate kit is worn for specific sports, learning environments and weather conditions. This decision will be made by teachers in loco-parentis. Students will be taught about keeping healthy, personal hygiene and the importance of organisation as part of their PE curriculum.

A mouthguard is compulsory for all hockey lessons, practices and matches (Years 3 to 6). Self-fit or custom built gum shields / mouthguards are widely available online and from retail outlets. In the interests of your child's safety, please make sure that any you purchase have the 'CE' mark of approval. SCHOOL BAGS

- School Rucksack (all year groups) - A navy rucksack with the school logo and your daughter's initials printed on is available to order through the Junior School Reception at a cost of £26.40 (subject to change). This is compulsory for all new pupils. This rucksack is appropriate in size and of good quality and it should serve your daughter for many years, without needing replacement. The use of initials is particularly helpful in ensuring that the girls look after their own property and also provides staff with instant visibility of NGHS girls, when on educational visits. Order forms are issued on a regular basis throughout the school year.
- House Waterproof Swimming Bag (all year groups) with school logo and your daughter's initials. This is compulsory for all new pupils. It is available to order through the Junior School Reception at a cost of £11.40 (subject to change). Order forms are issued on a regular basis throughout the school year.

SHOES

All girls should wear black shoes and for health and safety reasons, the heel must not exceed 2cm. Shoes should have velcro straps unless your daughter is able to tie her own shoelaces. The following are not acceptable:

- Slip-on shoes
- Ballet style pumps (they do not provide the necessary support)
- Boots
- Shoes with open heels/toes
- Canvas shoes or trainers

Styles of shoes which are suitable include the following, but if you have any doubt please contact your daughter's teacher for advice.



OTHER ITEMS / INFORMATION


- If hair is below collar length it must be tied back with a navy or black hair band or scrunchy. **Other decorative hair accessories are not permitted.**
- No jewellery is permitted except for one pair of small, plain gold or silver studs for pierced ears. Please note that earrings cannot be worn for swimming **under any circumstances** therefore please do not arrange for your daughter to have her ears pierced in the 2 months leading up to her swimming course (dates will be advised in due course).
- No jewellery can be worn for any PE activities.
- Shin pads are required for hockey lessons (Years 3 to 6).
- Please check that your daughter has the appropriate PE kit at school for each lesson and remind her to bring it home regularly for washing.

ETHNIC OR RELIGIOUS DRESS

Girls may wear special forms of dress or religious symbols where these are an essential part of their religious or cultural background and do not compromise health and safety. We would ask that any items of religiously symbolic jewellery be worn discreetly and be covered with a sweatband during sports..
