Arthropod Classes

Characteristics of arthropods

- 1. jointed legs
- 2. exoskeleton
- 3. segmented bodies

Millipedes

- 1. round with 2 pairs of legs per body segment (not 1000)
- 2. smelly liquid defense
- 3. herbivores (slow)

Centipedes

- 1. 1 pair of legs per segment
- 2. flat and fast
- 3. carnivores with jaws, fangs

Crustaceans

- 1. 2 or 3 body segments, 5+ pairs of legs, 3 appendages/claws for eating
- 2. microscopic larvae
- 3. carnivores or scavengers

Arachnids

- 1. 2 body segments, 4 pairs of legs, no antenna, simple eyes
- 2. some venomous (rashes)
- 3. mites, ticks, spiders, scorpions

Insects

- 1. 3 body sections (head, thorax, abdomen), 6 legs
- 2. antennae and compound eyes
- 3. defenses: speed, camo, numbers
