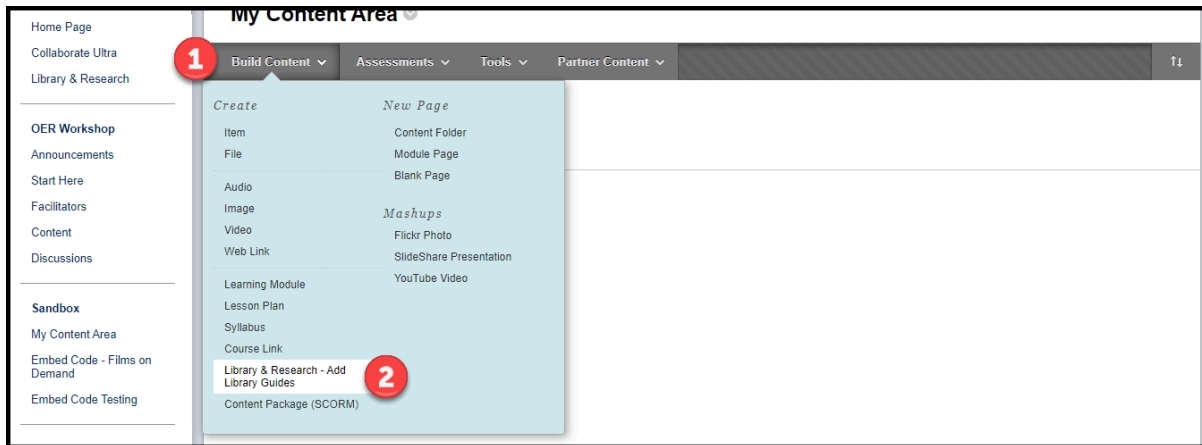


Add **Library & Research** to your Blackboard Course Content Area

You can add Library Guides (Subject Guides and Citation Guides content) to any Blackboard course content area.

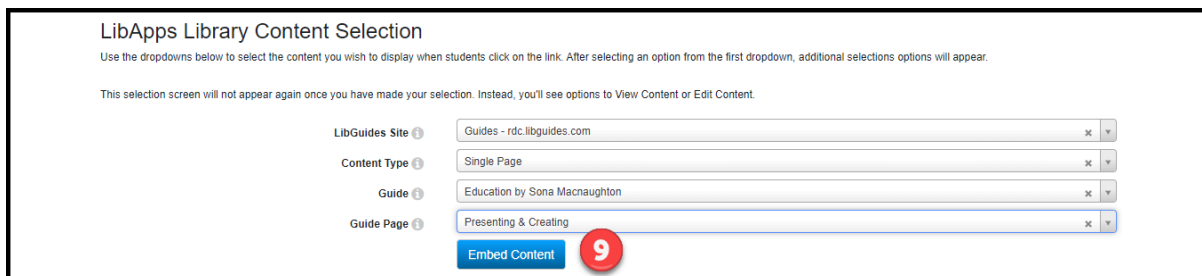
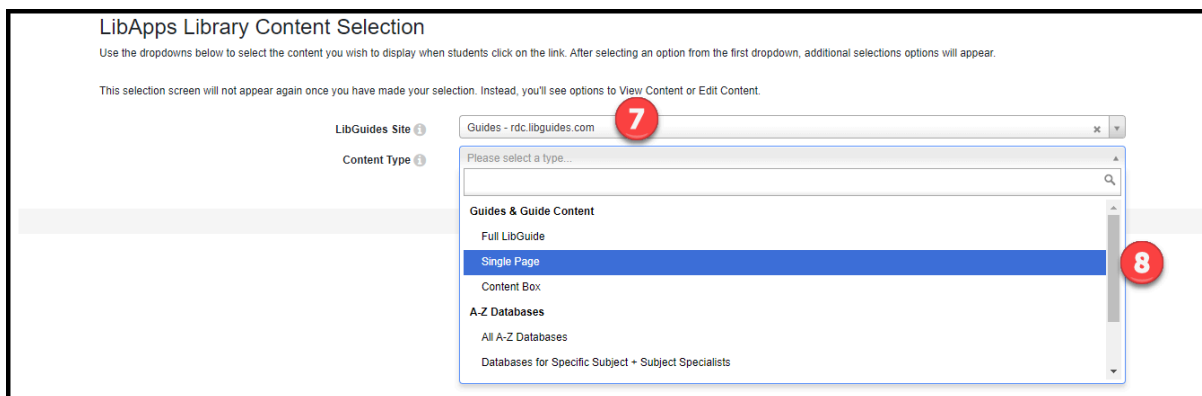
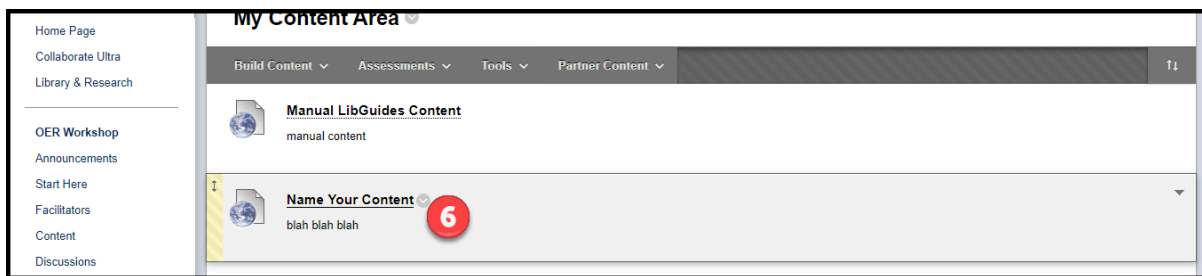
1. Go to the **Build Content** menu
2. Click on **Library & Research - Add Library Guides**



3. **Name your link**
4. Check **Yes** make content viewable
5. Click **Submit**
