ACHIEVEMENT AWARD PROGRAM (AAP) OVERVIEW

The Achievement Award Program (AAP) rewards chapters for their promotion, recognition, and outcomes of our Fraternity's pillars. The **AAP consists of 5 reports** spread across the school year, which are part of the Thurston Cup competition. AAP items, including the Brotherhood Report, are **optional**. Completion of the AAP is facilitated by the chapter's Worthy Correspondent with assistance from the entire chapter.

AWARDS

The Brotherhood trophy is awarded to the 1st place Brotherhood Report, and engraved plaques are awarded to 2nd and 3rd place. Monetary awards are given to the top 5 Saroyan Brotherhood Reports. Ralph Saroyan was Phi Delta Chi's Grand President from 1981 to 1989 and the inaugural Chairman of the Board for the Pharmacy Leadership and Education Institute (PLEI). Brother Saroyan also endowed the Saroyan Scholarship for many years to come.

Required Sections	- Title Page - Table of Contents - Headers for each of the 3 graded sections - Promotion - Regional/National Outcomes - Reflection Promotion includes events/initiatives that promote Brotherhood. Regional/National Outcomes includes attendance at regional and national PDC events as well as engagement with other PDC chapters. - The Brotherhood Reflection is an essay on what Brotherhood means to you and your chapter. The essay can be written by a collegiate Brother or multiple collegiate Brothers from your chapter. The essay should be no more than 2 pages. Chapters that submit something other than an essay or that do not choose ONE essay will most likely be disqualified. PDC Logo & Image Usage Phi Delta Chi has secured registered trademarks for several key Phi Delta Chi brand identifiers including PDC, Phi Delta Chi, our logo, and our crest. A Servicemark Agreement is required to be completed and submitted prior to use of these images. Compliance with our Brand Guidelines is also required. Standard Point Deductions:

- -1 points for every instance of not capitalizing "Brother" or "Phi Delta Chi" (*maximum 5 point deduction*)
- -5 points for every event included not within the specified time frame (*maximum 10 point deduction*)
- -5 points for report not being submitted in PDF format
- -5 points for not following the page limits
