## Waukegan Public School District #60 Campus Portal Acceptable Use Policy


The Waukegan Public School District #60 has developed the Campus Portal. This is a useful, up-to-date information system that allows our Waukegan School Community to focus on our student learning. The Parent Portal allows parents to view their own child's school records. The Portal is available to every parent or guardian of students enrolled in the Waukegan Public School District #60. For the privilege of accessing the Campus Portal, every parent is expected to act in a responsible, ethical and legal manner. Failure to do so may result in loss of privileges for accessing the Campus Portal. Parents are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Waukegan Public Schools continues to take cautionary measures to ensure the safety of our students, staff and community. For that reason we ask that you <u>please</u> contact your child's school parent support email in order to receive your account information. If you do not have access to email please contact your child's school.
- 2. Parents/guardians will each receive their own password for all their students.
- 3. Parents will not share their passwords with anyone.
- 4. Parents will not attempt to harm or destroy any data on any network.
- 5. Parents will not use Portal for any illegal activity, including violation of Data Privacy laws.
- Parents will not access data or any account owned by another parent or user.
- 7. Parents who identify a security problem with the Campus Portal must immediately notify Campus Portal Help Desk at portalhelp@wps60.org.
- 8. Parents should not demonstrate this problem to anyone else.
- 9. Users who believe that someone else has their password must immediately notify the Campus Portal Help Desk at portalhelp@wps60.org. Arrangements will be made to correct this problem and reassign a new password. Please allow up to one week for response time.
- 10. Users who are identified as a security risk to the Campus Portal or any other district systems will be denied access to the Campus Portal.


## Instructions for Accessing your Campus Portal

We recommend that you use either Chrome or Firefox to access Campus Portal, both web browsers are available for free download. If you do not have access to the Parent Portal please see your school office and/or email <a href="mailto:portalhelp@wps60.org">portalhelp@wps60.org</a> to request access.

<u>Step One:</u> Go to <u>www.wps60.org</u> and proceed to hover your cursor over the **Parents & Students** link on the page. On the drop downs that open, select on the link titled **Parent Portal - Infinite Campus.** 






## Proceed to selecting Campus Parent;







<u>Step Three:</u> Enter your Username and Password <u>exactly</u> as it appears in your letter, and then select the <u>Log In</u> button.



**Step Four:** You will be prompted to securely set up your Portal account; the first task is to change your account's password. To do this, enter the password that was given to you, then enter a new strong password; which should include letters and numbers. If the bar next to New Password is not green 100% after you have typed in your new password, you will not be able to save it.
