Hudson School District Special Board of Education Meeting November 25, 2024

Open Session

1. A special meeting of the Hudson Board of Education was called to order by Board President Jamie Johnson at 5:30 p.m.

The meeting was conducted in person at the Hudson School District Administrative Service Center, 644 Brakke Drive, Hudson, WI. The following people attended in person; Bob Baumann, Rob Brown, Kate Garza, Jamie Johnson, Molly Powers, Megan Rozowski, Superintendent Nick Ouellette, Assistant Superintendent Dave Grambow, Chief Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker, Chief of Schools Officer Tara Gonyer, Assistant Director of Finance Traci Lewis, and Assistant Director of Community Relations Tracy Habisch-Ahlin.

- 2. Assistant Director of Finance Traci Lewis provided an update on the 2024-2025 budget.
- 3. Superintendent Nick Ouellette highlighted construction progress at both North Hudson and E. P. Rock elementary schools. The Middle School pool will need to be closed for eight weeks in the spring, and the groups impacted will be notified.
- 4. Chief Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker asked the Board for input on the Cheers for Peers program and what changes they might like to see.
- Assistant Superintendent Dave Grambow provided information on the recently released state report cards and offered comparisons between Hudson and other districts. Grambow will provide additional information at the January Board meeting.
- 6. With the recently released state report cards the administration is recommending raising some of the District Goals. The final 2024-2025 District Goals will be presented at the December Board meeting for Board approval.
- 7. Superintendent Ouellette led a discussion on possible next steps following the failed referendum last month. The Board and Administration discussed the impacts of possible budget cuts and asked for input from the Teacher Advisory Committee.
- 8. At 8:10 p.m. Rozowski moved, with a second by Baumann, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.
