Police Report

Chief McEnerney reported that there is some mandatory training that all personnel will be taking on de-escalation. A resident at Clyde and Overlook requested guidance from the board (through the Chief) on curb protection possibilities (pylon, stones, etc.).

Engineer's Report

Sarah and Brian were not present this month. Brian Wesolowski sent a letter recommending that we pay the patching vendor (Schroeder Asphalt) for their services, and the bill was included in the Monthly Transaction Report this month. There will be one more upcoming resolution for MFT funds.

Legislative Matters

Trustee Ross moved to approve a resolution approving a first amendment to agreement between the villages of Glenview and Golf concerning fire protection and other emergency services as prepared by Village Attorney Bruce Huvard. Trustee Landman seconded the motion.

Reports

Approval of Bills

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to approve the monthly transaction report for October 2025 as prepared by Village Administrator Michelle Shapiro. Trustee Ross seconded the motion.

Emergency Services Department

Trustee Ross had nothing to report. Bruce Huvard confirmed the Village's approach to e-bikes, based on his research.

Building and Zoning Department

Trustee Burden reported that destruction of records that no longer need (anything before 2010) to be kept is going well. A resident suggested that we email the residents about the architectural drawings and those will be saved if requested.

There was a suggestion that we look at permitting for tents (in backyards for parties), but based on research, there is no need and the website has been updated with guidance.

Public Buildings and Grounds Department

Lucas Landscaping has cleared a few trees in the parkway so that cars and buses can get through, however, he did not address any Oak or Elm trees since those need to be addressed in the spring. Trustee Shine has been working with Lucas to add more trees and replace the trees that have been cleared, including a diverse approach with gingko, tulip, japanese ivory silk and redbud varieties. He also met with Landscape Concepts Management to discuss how the area can be improved around the hall and the train station with mulch under the trees, fall decorations, etc.

Trustee Miller moved to approve \$5,997 for fall cleaning and additional \$1,000 for the beautification by the Metra as drafted with Landscape Concepts Management and Trustee Shine. Trustee Kalogerakos seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by roll call vote as follows:

There may be other areas that need attention in the spring including the west side of the train station.

Finance and Administration Department

Trustee Miller shared that our financial position remains strong. He also reported that we are waiting on property tax revenue from Cook County.

President Farr shared that we will be able to accept Zelle for the police holiday fund and the fireworks.

Streets and Sanitation Department

Trustee Kalogerakos reported that the light at 60 Overlook was replaced with a solar solution for less than \$1K. He also shared that the Metra parking lot lines were redone and resealed.

Utilities Department

Trustee Landman nothing new to report, as we discussed the cost share program previously. Next step will be to communicate the program to the Village and homeowners.

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Landman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:49 pm.
