**AN ORDER CREATING THE BARANGAY ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE
MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF BARANGAY _____**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003 otherwise known as the “PHILIPPINE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000”, providing for a systematic, comprehensive and ecological waste management program was approved by the Congress of the Philippines on January 26, 2001;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the aforementioned Act, articulates that; Pursuant to the relevant provisions of Republic Act 7610, otherwise known as the LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, the local government units shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the same within their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, corollary to the above, Section 17, paragraphs (a) and (b), sub-paragraph (iii) of the LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, expressly pronounce that; x x x Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities x x x. *Such basic services and facilities include x x x services and facilities related to general hygiene and sanitation, beautification, and solid waste collection;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, _____, Punong Barangay of _____, Lamitan City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law do hereby order the creation of the Barangay Ecological Solid Waste Management Committee, to wit:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Barangay Ecological Solid Waste Management Committee (BESWMC) shall be composed of the following:

Representative from Junkshop Owners Association

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The BESWMC shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate a community solid waste management program consistent with the City;
2. Be responsible for the segregation and collection of solid waste specifically for biodegradable, compostable and reusable wastes;
3. Establish within the barangay or cluster of barangays a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), a redemption or eco-centers in a barangay-owned or leased land or any suitable open space to be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay;
4. Allocate funds for the barangay ecological solid waste management program, approved by the Sangguniang Barangay;
5. Organize a Core of Area/Street Coordinators to assist the BESWMC in the implementation of their programs and activities;
6. Conduct trainings for barangay residents on segregation, composting, recycling and livelihood opportunities from use of recyclable waste and to monitor their implementation;
7. Integrate the Ecological Solid Waste Management Program in the Barangay Development Plan (BDP) and/or Annual Investment Program (AIP);
8. Find alternative sources of funds other than the regular barangay budget;
9. Submit a monthly report to the City ESWMB on the progress of the program, copy furnished city MILG Office.
10. Implement policies and plans on the following:

a. Education

- i. Develop and disseminate IEC materialson solid waste management to every household, business establishment, and other institutions in the barangay;
- ii. Conduct community trainings and seminars on ecological solid waste segregation, composting, reduction of waste for disposal and recycling; and
- iii. Issuance of community policies that will patronize ecologically friendly products and packaging.

b. Engineering

- i. Provision of support mechanisms for segregated collection; and
- ii. Setting up redemption or eco-centers (MRF) within the barangay for non-biodegradable or recyclable materials before selling in bulk to junk shops.

c. Enforcement

- i. Enact barangay ordinances on the establishment of an awards system and other incentives and sanctions in the barangay; and other rules and regulations to implement the program.

d. Entrepreneurial

- i. Establish a system of buying and selling of recyclable wastes including composts;
- ii. Promote livelihood activities from waste materials;
- iii. Networking with the private/business establishments within the barangay; and
- iv. Microfinancing for livelihood projects from waste.

SECTION 3. SECRETARIAT. The barangay secretary shall serve as the Secretariat of the BESWMC.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
