

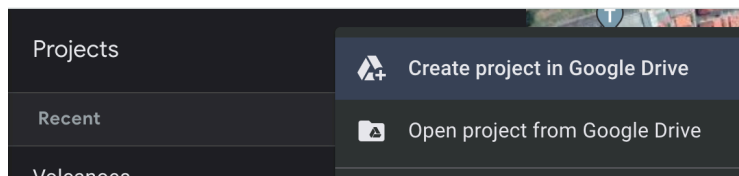
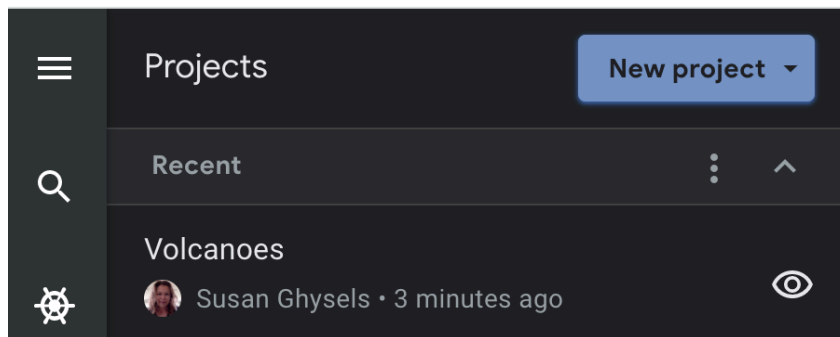

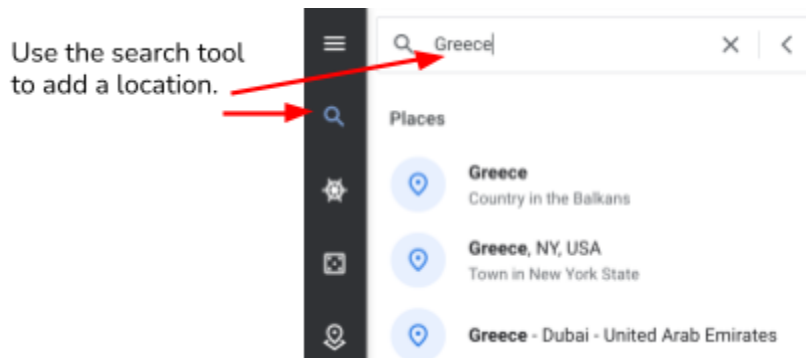
- Virtual Field Trip to look at art, architecture, geologic formations

Open [Google Earth](#) and begin a New Project created in Google Drive

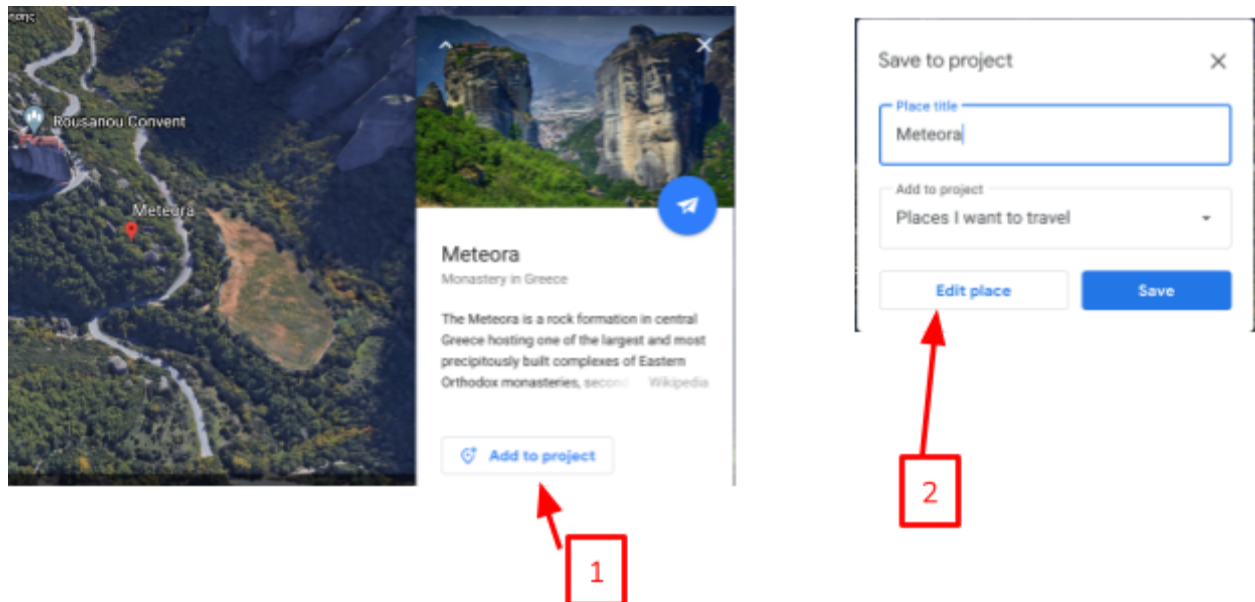


Adding Locations

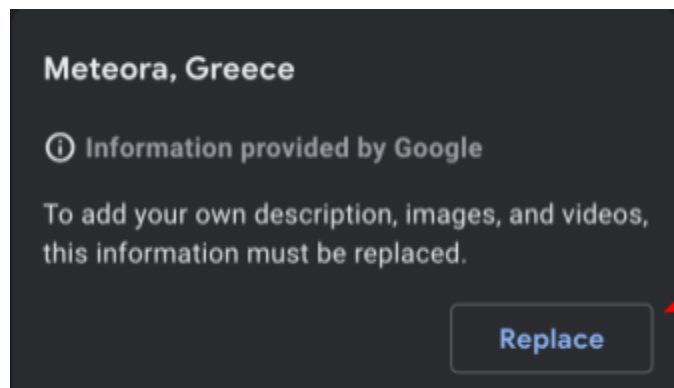


Narrow your search by using specific terms. For example searching a specific feature of the country, like Meteora, Greece.

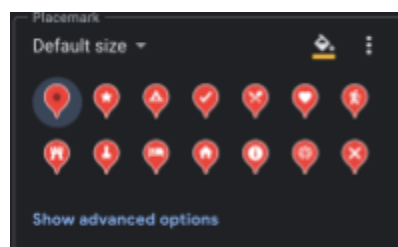
Save and edit the location.



Now you can add text, photos, and videos about this location.



Replace the information provided by Google.




Edit the place marker icon if you like. You can change the size, symbol, and color.

Saving the Project
