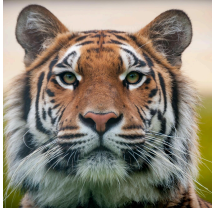

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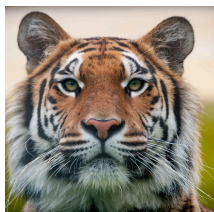

**Minutes:** Principal Roseboro started meeting off with a welcome and introductions. He went on to review the agenda and stated this meeting is a working meeting to look at the SPSA to add comments and edit Section 4 as needed and review the protocols and procedures of the Comprehensive Safety School Plan. Alejandro inquired about how to measure if the SPSA is being met and who will monitor CBOs and the family engagement activities. Victoria spoke about the alignment of writing the Implementation Grant to support the SPSA. There will be a

Community Schools Committee that will monitor CBOs and have a Family Engagement Committee with the family liaisons. Principal Roseboro indicated that the 2026-27 school year will show the SPSA being integrated as part of the Professional Engagement Scope and Sequence. Cherie Kong proposed a correction to the language for an .08 FTE clerk, which it says in the 2025-26 SPSA. She was hired as a Chinese support, but it should be for Mandarin. As to continue the review and editing process of the SPSA, it will be updated at the Instructional Leadership Team meeting on April 15 Once all feedback is added, the finalized version of the SPSA will show as complete then sent on April 16 for SSC review and approval on April 17th Comprehensive School Safety Plan (CSSP) reviewed with highlighted updates and it was approved.

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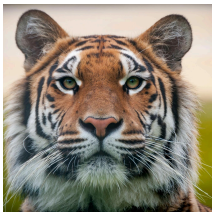

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

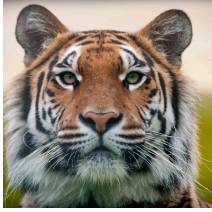

Family Engagement w Focal Students. ELPAC- according to STARS 43.8% progress since 23-24 ( Reading, Listening, Writing, Speaking is done w 3rd party). Schoolwide +23% testing out of ELPAC, See budget in PP(Mr. R).big cuts Proposals. The Student Success Fund Grant ends this school year. Unable to apply for Community Schools Implementation Grant if we do not hire a Community Schools Coordinator. 3-5 yr grant. Salesforce \$100k (Principal's Discretion: FTE Comp Science Teacher YR1, YR2 split - resources needed, hope is to have the district pay FTE Comp Sci). School Planning Goals to Cont.! Vision for Aptos- Become a performing Arts School to feed into SOTA, Deeper Learning, Focal Students Achieve Sense of Belonging, Literacy across Content and Math. All to align with SPSA.

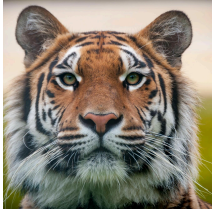

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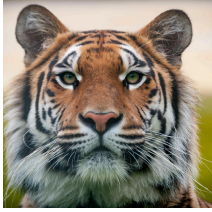

We reviewed the school safety plan. Already did lockdown, secure, and fire drill, earthquake is upcoming october 16th. We discussed tsunami warning protocol and protocol of principal actions during warnings. Tsunami warning protocol will be put in "What's Happening at Aptos" weekly memo. Did lockdown as a school, will have another drill in the spring. We acknowledged: engaging with law enforcement guidelines, student walkout guidelines, sandy hook promise. Fire drill lockdown earthquake and secure #2 drills will repeat in the spring semester. Emergency bags check in fall semester. Emergency plan, either run by

Roseboro or Kia Clark if Roseboro is absent. Low to High Impact threats, in each case email to families and staff by EOD. Need Five SRP Actions posters in all classrooms. Went over evacuation sites with a map, black top field and Sloat Elementary as a second site. Plan to go over protocols with the whole staff at the next staff meeting, Wednesday 10/15. The School Site Council reviewed and approved our Comprehensive School Safety Plan.
