General Opportunities

Sign up to volunteer with TDP's Voter Protection Team by completing our Volunteer Opportunity form at txdem.co/voprovol and a member of our team will follow up with you!

Hotline Volunteers

Answer voters' phone calls from voters with questions ranging from "how do I register to vote?" to "I'm at the polling place and they're saying I can't vote" to "I need help correcting a problem with my mail ballot." - **Logistics**
 - Location: Remote - This is done from your home computer
 - During VBM/Early Voting: Late August - mid-November, shifts available from 9 AM - 5 PM CST (includes weekend shifts)
 - On Election Day: 7 AM - 7 PM
- **Supports Provided**
 - Required Trainings: An on-demand or live Hotline Training and a live Technical Support Training
 - Hotline FAQs Manual
 - Real-time Captain support during your shift
- **Great Opportunity for folks who are...**
 - Computer comfortable (can use websites & follow training)
 - Patient
 - Problem solvers and diligent
 - Huge Bonus: Conversational in Spanish
 - Poll Watchers: You can participate during VBM since poll watching only starts once early voting begins

Poll Watchers

Poll watchers are voters' advocates at the polling place. They are the last line of defense for a voter to ensure they're able to vote. They observe the check-in and voting process at an assigned polling place. Sign up at: txdem.co/voprovol

- **Logistics**
 - Location: In person, at a polling place
 - During Early Voting: Monday, Oct. 21 - Friday, Nov. 1. (preferably at least 1-2 days or half days)
 - During Election Day: Tuesday, November 5 (preferably all day)
- **Supports Provided**
 - Required Trainings: Completion of two on-demand trainings are required (Complete the TDP training first and then complete the Secretary of State training)
 - Optional Live trainings and office hours
 - Continued voter education opportunities throughout summer

 - Good problem solvers or lawyers or legal professionals
 - Emotionally intelligence or observant
 - Willing to advocate constructively for someone else

As a member of the Election Administration Ambassadors Team, you will connect with a County Chair or a Democratic campaign where you will work with local officials and the TDP VoPro team to open up voting access there. You'll build a relationship with the election official, identify opportunities for improving access, and advocate for voters.

 - Location: Can be remote or in person
 - Through the end of the ballot cure period (November 11)
- **Supports Provided**
 - Required, continued trainings
 - Live support from TDP Voter Protection Team
