Viper Valor Board Celebrations - Recognizing the best in our band and Vision community

VIEW THE VIRTUAL VALOR BOARD

Over the course of sixteen weeks during the spring, the Viper Band and Vision Dance Company will focus on eight core values of being a great team member, citizen, and human. We will celebrate students for demonstrating examples or acts of kindness, patience, selflessness, joy, gentleness, resourcefulness, discipline, and extraordinary behavior. We encourage our students to use this Google form to share examples of other students modeling these traits that they witness in their daily interactions and index cards to post on a board in the band hall. Each time a student demonstrates behaviors that represent these words, we have an opportunity to reinforce these values. As band and Vision members enter and exit the band hall, they can stop to read examples of "Viper Valor.

We will begin on Monday, 1-27, with "**KINDNESS**." This will be the virtue we explore in classes and rehearsals for the next two weeks. Students are encouraged to recognize their peers using the form above for acts of kindness. They can be simple in nature -- we want to celebrate all acts, little and big.

<u>Sectional Rehearsals</u>

Weekly sectional rehearsals for all woodwind and brass are underway. These weekly rehearsals are mandatory for all members of the section scheduled. Conflicts should be communicated well in advance to directors.

Solo and Ensemble vs. Solo Concerto Contest information vs. Chamber Music

We have three different events at VHS for students to work solos or ensemble music:

UIL Solo and Ensemble – A limited number of VHS students may attend this event to qualify for the UIL State Solo and Ensemble contest. Students begin preparing a solo from the Prescribed Music List (PML) in November/December and have an accompanist. They will compete in March to earn the opportunity to advance to the UIL State Solo Contest, which is held annually in May each year in Austin. Students should speak to one of the band directors.

VHS Concerto Contest (Solo Contest) – Held at VHS each spring in April and May, this is our campus solo and ensemble contest, where students prepare solos to compete and perform on campus. This process is open to all students, and participation is highly encouraged. We have NOT done sign-up for this yet. Students should work with their lesson teachers to select a solo. If a student needs help, they can ask any band director.

Chamber Music – Held at VHS. Open to all students. Chamber music groups are groups of students who all play the same instruments. Since our sections don't get to meet all together after marching season ends, our chamber groups allow our students a weekly opportunity to play together under the direction of one of our studio teachers. These are low stress, fun rehearsals that are more for bonding and camaraderie. Younger players can learn from our older players. We will prepare music together to perform at the March 6th concert. Mr. Murray coordinates chamber music, and students can still participate. Percussion students perform in ensembles that they work in class every day, for their March 4th concert.
