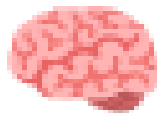

complete the [medication form](#), including signatures from the prescribing doctor and parent. Meds must be turned in to the office, by the parent/guardian, in the original bottle/packaging.

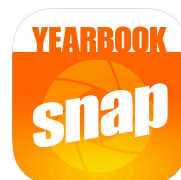
