Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how Ink Art & Photography (“we,” “us,” or “our”) collects, uses, discloses, and protects personal information when you visit our website, contact us, purchase artwork or services, or interact with us offline. By using our services or providing personal information, you agree to this policy.

Information We Collect

Contact and identity: name, email address, phone number, billing and shipping address.

Transaction and account data: order history, payment details (payment processors handle full card data), invoices.

Communications: messages, inquiries, customer service correspondence, and any content you send (e.g., commission briefs).

Content you provide: photos, reference images, and files you upload for commissions or prints.

Usage and technical data: IP address, browser type, device identifiers, pages visited, and cookies.

Marketing preferences and consent choices.

Optional: social media handles and public profile data if you connect accounts.

How We Use Your Information

To provide and deliver art, prints, commissions, and services.

To process payments, manage orders, and fulfill contracts.

To communicate about orders, commissions, customer service, updates, and promotional offers (with your consent where required).

To personalize your experience and improve our website, products, and services.

To detect, prevent, and address fraud, security issues, or legal claims.

To comply with legal obligations.

Legal Basis (where applicable) We process personal data based on:

Performance of a contract (orders, commissions).

Legitimate interests (fraud prevention, site analytics, service improvement).

Consent (marketing communications, where required).

Legal compliance.

Sharing and Disclosure We may share personal information with:

Service providers (payment processors, hosting, shipping, email platforms, printers) who act as processors.

Freelancers, collaborators, or subcontractors involved in fulfilling commissions (only necessary info).

- *Business partners in connection with co-promotions (with your consent).*
- *In a business transfer (sale or reorganization) subject to confidentiality and notice.*

Your Rights

 - Object to processing or withdraw consent.*
 - Restrict processing.*

Data Retention

- 1. We retain personal information as long as necessary for the purposes described (e.g., to fulfill orders, comply with tax and accounting obligations, defend legal claims) or as required by law.*

Security

- 2. We implement reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect personal data. No method of transmission or storage is 100% secure; however, we take steps to safeguard your information.*

Minors

- 3. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 (or higher age where required). If we learn we collected such data without parental consent, we will delete it promptly.*

International Transfers

- 4. If you are outside our country, your data may be transferred to and processed in countries with different data protection laws. We will take appropriate safeguards to protect your information.*

Marketing

- 5. We will only send marketing communications where you have consented or where permitted by law. You can opt out at any time via unsubscribe links or by contacting us.*
