

WHEEL CHAIR TO TOILET TRANSFERS

- Place gait belt around waist;
- Take resident into bathroom facing the toilet;
- Be sure foot plates on the wheel chair have been removed and the wheelchair brakes have been locked;
- Instruct resident to pull feet back (nose over toes), place hands on the chair, lean forward, and stand;
- Cue resident to turn, using toilet grab bars for balance as needed;
- Have them use one hand to hold on and the other to pull down their pants enough to sit down, changing hands as needed;
- Cue them to sit down.

Reverse the process to go back to the chair
