District Partners break ground for new Masscom dormitory

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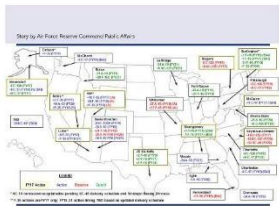

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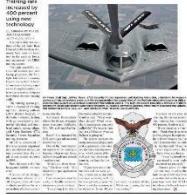


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MILO system offers realistic force training
