CALLING*

*If you're calling everyday, make sure you also say that you haven't received a response, despite numerous calls and requests. They have to track this information!

HOW TO CALL:

1. Use the 5CALLS app on your phone
2. Call the individual numbers listed in the chart below.
3. Use this link to automate calls: https://mbl.ms/l_LupEBidsv

Enter your information so it can find who your representative is. You will then get a call and be transferred to each of your elected officials (you don't have to hang up and redial! Keep pressing (star*) after each call and you'll be transferred to the next official).

TALKING POINTS/SCRIPT:

I'm calling regarding the ongoing genocide in Gaza. I urge you to:

- 1) Call for an immediate and sustained ceasefire. Sign HR Resolution 786.
- 2) Call for the allowance of humanitarian aid into Gaza
- 3) Refuse ANY aid package that includes Israel. I refuse to allow my tax money to fund this genocide
- 4) My vote for you in this next election will be contingent upon your action on these matters.

EMAILING

*If you're emailing everyday, make sure you also say that you haven't received a response, despite numerous messages and requests. They have to track this information!

TALKING POINTS/SCRIPT:

My name is [your name], I live in [city/county] and I am your constituent.

I am emailing you regarding the ongoing genocide in Gaza. I urge you to call for an immediate and sustained ceasefire. An immediate and sustained ceasefire is necessary for the release of all hostages, including Palestinians held in administrative detention in Israel without due process, and the entry of critical humanitarian aid to prevent further loss of life, as the 7-day pause clearly demonstrated. I also urge you to sign the House Cease-fire Now Resolution [For the US Senate use this line instead: support the introduction of a Senate companion to the Ceasefire Now Resolution].

As a tax paying citizen, I refuse to allow my tax money to be used toward ANY aid package that includes Israel. We give Israel \$3 billion each year while we struggle to fund basic healthcare and combat rising costs here at home. Please vote NO on **any** supplemental funding package to send more weapons to Israel.

Detroit, Hamtramck, Ypsilanti, Wayne County, Canton Township, Dearborn and Dearborn heights have made it clear where Michigan stands. Other cities are following suit. Listen to your constituents' demands. I am tracking where politicians stand on the dire crisis unfolding in Palestine; failure to sign-off on these resolutions and policies will play a direct role in my votes for the 2024 election.
