


Type in your question and answer options. Then, select the correct answer by clicking the checkmark next to the option. You can preview your question on the right side of the screen.




Search for a quiz topic using either of the two Search bars.






Preview the quiz questions by scrolling down. Click <u>Copy and Edit</u> if you would like to make changes.



You can create a new question, import questions from other quizzes, or click edit to modify it.




#### Click Save.




To view your saved quiz from the main menu, click My library.




Click <u>Start a live quiz</u> to play the quiz synchronously with your class.






## Look through the Settings and adjust as needed.





Provide students with the link and Quiz code. You will see student names pop up at the bottom of the screen. Once everyone is in, click **Start**.




Keep track of the accuracy and leaderboard to see how students are doing. Click End to finish the game when all students have answered the questions.




## Asynchronous Quizizz:
