Privacy Policy

I. Introduction

- a. MARCO MEDICAL MANAGEMENT, LLC (the “Company” or “We”) respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this privacy policy (this “Policy”). This Policy describes the types of information We may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit our website www.marcomedicalmgmt.com (our “Website”) and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.
- b. This Policy applies to information We collect: (i) on our Website; (ii) in email, text, or other electronic messages between you and our Website, whether through the contact form or otherwise; and (iii) through our Website’s of Google Analytics (the separate terms of service for which can be found [here](#)).
- c. This Policy does not apply to information collected by: (i) us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by the Company or any third party; (ii) any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or through our Website.
- d. Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how We will treat it. If you do not agree with this Policy your choice is to not use our Website or disclose any information to us. By accessing or using our Website, you agree to this Policy.

II. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

- a. We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information: (i) by which you may be personally identified, such as name, mailing address, email address, and telephone number (collectively “Personal Information”); (ii) that is about you but individually does not identify you such as your location and the language in which you view our Website; and/or (iii) about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website, usage details such as the URL and title of the page you are viewing, the name of the browser you are using, the size of the browser window, the resolution of your screen, and whether or not you have Java enabled. We collect this information directly from you when you provide it to us; automatically as you navigate through our Website; and from or via third parties, such as Google Analytics.
- b. The information We collect on or through our Website may include: (i) information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website; (ii) information when you report a problem with our Website and records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us; and (iii) your search queries on our Website.
- c. As you navigate through and interact with our Website, We may use automatic data collection technologies such as Google Analytics to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including: (i) details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on our Website; (ii) information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type. The information We collect automatically is only statistical data and does not include Personal Information, but We may maintain it or associate it with Personal Information We collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website

and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to estimate our audience size and usage patterns; store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests; speed up your searches; and recognize you when you return to our Website. The technologies We use for this automatic data collection may include cookies (or browser cookies) which is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer and web beacons. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website. Certain pages of our Website may contain small electronic files known as web beacons that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages and for other related Website statistics.

III. **Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies**

- a. Some content on the Website is served by third parties. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you use our Website. The information they collect may be associated with your Personal Information or they may collect information, including Personal Information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based advertising or other targeted content. We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. If you have any questions about an advertisement or other targeted content, you should contact the responsible provider directly.

IV. **How We Use Your Information**

- a. We use information that We collect about you or that you provide to us, including any Personal Information: (i) to present our Website and its contents to you; (ii) to provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us; (iii) to fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it; (iv) to carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us; (v) to notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services We offer or provide through it; (vi) for direct marketing; (vii) in any other way We may describe when you provide the information; and (ix) for any other purpose with your consent.
- b. We may also use your information to contact you about our own and third parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you. If you do not want us to use your information in this way, please do not submit any information or use our Website.

V. **Disclosure of Your Information**

- a. We may disclose aggregated information about users of our Website and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.
- b. We may disclose Personal Information that We collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy: (i) to our subsidiaries and affiliates; (ii) to contractors, service providers, and other third parties We use to support our business; (iii) to a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale, or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Information held by the Company and our Website users is among the assets transferred; (iv) To third parties to market their products or services to you; (v) to fulfill the purpose for which you

provide it; (vi) for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information; and (vii) with your consent.

- c. We may also disclose your Personal Information: (i) to comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request; (ii) to enforce or apply our terms of use which are available [here](#) (“Terms of Use”) and other agreements; or (iii) if We believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.

VI. Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

- a. We strive to provide you with choices regarding the Personal Information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:
 - i. Tracking Technologies. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some pages of our Website may then be inaccessible or not function properly.
 - ii. Disclosure of Your Information for Third-Party Advertising. If you do not want us to share your Personal Information with unaffiliated or non-agent third parties for promotional purposes, please do not submit any information or use our Website.
 - iii. Promotional Offers from the Company. If you do not wish to have your name, postal address, email address, phone number, and other contact information used by the Company to promote our own or third parties’ products or services, please do not submit any information or use our Website. If We have sent you a promotional email, you may send us a return email asking to be omitted from future email distributions.
 - iv. Targeted Advertising. If you do not want us to use information that We collect or that you provide to us to deliver advertisements, please do not submit any information or use our Website.
- b. We do not control third parties’ collection or use of your information to serve interest-based advertising. However these third parties may provide you with ways to choose not to have your information collected or used in this way. You can opt out of receiving targeted ads from members of the Network Advertising Initiative (“NAI”) on the NAI’s Website.
- c. Residents of certain states, such as California, Nevada, Colorado, Connecticut, Virginia, and Utah may have additional Personal Information rights and choices. Please see Section VII for more information.
- d. You can change your Personal Information by sending us an email to the address listed in Section XI to correct any Personal Information that you have provided to us. We may not accommodate a request to change information if We believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

VII. Your State Privacy Rights

- a.** State consumer privacy laws may provide their residents with additional rights regarding our use of their Personal Information. To the extent applicable to the Company, California’s “Shine the Light” law (Civil Code Section § 1798.83) permits users of our Website that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of Personal Information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes. VIII. **Data Security**

- a. We have implemented measures designed to secure your Personal Information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure and all information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers behind firewalls.
- b. The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where We have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of our Website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.
- c. Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although We do our best to protect your Personal Information, We cannot guarantee the security of your Personal Information or any information transmitted to our Website. Any transmission of Personal Information or other information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on our Website.

IX. **Changes to Our Privacy Policy**

- a. The Company reserves the right to change this Privacy Notice at any time in our sole discretion without prior notice, so check back frequently to review our current Privacy Policy. By using this Website, You represent and warrant that You are of legal age to form a binding contract with the Company pursuant to the Terms of Use and meet all of the foregoing eligibility requirements. If You do not meet all of these requirements, You must not access or Use the Website or provide any Personal Information.
