TOLI in Taha has grown quickly this past year – they've gone from having 10 active clients to 61 and have served a total of 81 clients. These clients raise chickens, own shops, are hairdressers, and even sell prepaid cell phone cards. **Mira and Christine**, the two TOLI Social Workers in

this region, walk with clients in a caring way and get to know each one's story and testimony.

Eid (pictured) is a TOLI client with a disability. He's confined to a wheelchair, but this hasn't stopped him from growing his businesses of raising and selling chickens. He's saved money and been able to reinvest it in his business in order to expand. Most importantly, Eid has a heart for the Lord. He speaks softly, but he uses his beautiful voice to sing in the choir of church, where he finds his purpose.

Ayman took a TOLI microloan to set up a small carpentry workshop in his home. At first, he finished small projects that he delivered to people's homes. Now, he has dreams to expand his workshop and is starting to take larger jobs.
