Regular school attendance is more important than ever for a student's success and well-being. Getting into the habit of being at school every day from the start helps to:

- **Reduce stress** by preventing students from falling behind on their work.

As of Friday, students have had 18 days of school. Students who have missed more than two days are considered **chronically absent**, as their absenteeism rate is over 10%. Cell Phone Policy—CCPS (updated)

Recent changes in Virginia law require updates to our division cell phone policy. Under the new legislation, all Virginia schools must be "cell phone free" for grades PK-12 from "bell to bell - meaning from the first bell of the school day until dismissal. To comply with these requirements, our School Board recently passed a new Cell Phone Policy and Cell Phone Regulation. We encourage you to read the attached policy and regulation for full details.

J-WMS Dress Code

Students are welcome to choose school-appropriate outfits with the following limitations and guidelines:

- All clothing shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments and ensure that the chest, torso, midriff, behind and armpits are adequately covered at all times.
- Pants, skirts, bottoms must fit snuggly at the waist and be near fingertip length when arms are extended. Belts, if worn, shall be through the loops and not hang-down.
- Any tears, rips, cuts, and/or see-through material on bottoms/pants should be below the student's fingertips when arms are extended.

- Shoes must be worn at all times. Athletic shoes shall be worn for PE.
- Accessories must be safe and non-suggestive.

Students may NOT wear any of the following during the school day:

- Clothing that does not represent our commitment to respect, acceptance and inclusion
- Clothing that references drugs, alcohol, weapons, violence, sex, gang activity, racism, bigotry, vandalism, or vulgar language.
- Hats or hoods while in the building
- Accessories should not disrupt the learning environment.

Please refrain from wearing spikes, chains, dog collars, and gloves in the building

- Pajamas, blankets, slippers or other sleepwear

If students are not dressed appropriately, the steps that we take are as follows:

- Students are asked by a staff member to adhere to the dress code and may be referred to an administrator
- If a student fixes the problem by borrowing clothes from the school, another student, or calls home for a change of clothes, no other actions will be taken. Student will return to class upon fixing the problem.
- Upon refusal to fix a dress code violation, disciplinary actions will be taken.

Athletic Registration

We would like to start this email with an apology about the registration service. Arbiter bought rSchool during the past school year and the transition has not been smooth to say the least. At the onset of the transition we were told that they were working on a process to transfer the accounts from the rSchool service to Arbiter. After many conversations with Arbiter support over the last two months without much actual information we finally got an answer today (07/14) on a phone call that Arbiter was not working to transfer the accounts and that this is not a possibility. We apologize in advance for the confusion that this may have caused on your end. We are not happy to have to pass this information on to you, but we do not have any control over this situation. This means that you will need to create a new account on Arbiter to register participants for Athletics.
